Dr. Albert Burke, a dynamic American educator, economist and world-traveller, will explore the dynamics of communism versus democracy when he speaks about Ideas in Conflict in a public lecture Thursday night at 8 p.m.

Dr. Burke, originator of the TV program Probe and The Cutting Edge has lived in Russia, Germany, Czechoslovakia, Latin America and Asia and is fluent in six languages. He has taught both political science and international relations.

Newsweek described him as having "a mind like a barracuda" and the New York Times called him "provocative, sensible and challenging."

He is coming to campus under the auspices of the Cultural Affairs of the University. The public is invited to attend.
