<u>Hawks Capture Division Title</u>

Meet Loyola For Conference Championship

Waterloo Lutheran University Golden Hawks swept past the University of Windsor Lancers 43-13 last Saturday to close out the regular 1968 football schedule with a five wins-one loss record and the western division title of the Central Canada Intercollegiate Football Conference. The victory moves the Hawks into the conference championship game with Loyola University Warriors of Montreal.

Led by John Skinner and Tom McColl each with two touchdowns, WLU rolled up a total offense of 540 yds. The defense was almost as impressive as it held the Lancers to only 39 yds. rushing and two first downs along the ground.

Loyola, the eastern section winners, swamped Sir George Williams University 63-3 to finish the regular season undefeated.

Saturday's game which is slated for 2 p.m. at Seagram Stadium could very well be a battle of the defenses. The Golden Hawks have always accentuated a tough defensive squad and this season is no exception.

Loyola at the same time has put together a team that has only allowed 18 points scored against it in all six regular season games.

Head coach, David Knight, will have to receive a great team effort if his squad hopes to advance in search of a berth in the Canadian College Bowl.
