Warriors Flying High

But Hawks Feel They Can Be Beaten

As expected, the University of Waterloo warriors are riding high in the standings of the O.Q.A.A. for another season. However, on any given night they can be beaten as the University of Western Ontario proved just a week ago.

Coach Ted Maki of the Waterloo Lutheran University Golden Hawks feels that his club can and will give the warriors just as tough a game as they did earlier this season. That contest was won 2-1 by the warriors, as great goal tending and missed scoring opportunities kept the count low.

Coach Maki says that Western proved that the warriors have weaknesses and make mistakes just like everyone else. If the Hawks can force U of W into enough tight situations then Coach Maki's squad should be able to pump home a few goals.

The WLU squad has lost its past two starts, 5-3 to Laurentian and 2-1 to Ryerson, and is hoping to bounce back into the win column. This is a tough team and one of the best to play for Waterloo Lutheran in many years.

All indications would suggest that Thursday night's contest between the warriors and the Hawks should be one of the best of the 68-69 season. Game time is slated for 8 p.m. at the Kitchener Memorial Auditorium.
