400 Graduate at Fall Convocation  
of Waterloo Lutheran University

Nearly 400 students received degrees Sunday at the fall convocation of Waterloo Lutheran University, conducted at the Kitchener Memorial Auditorium.

Receiving honorary degrees were Mrs. Roland Michener, wife of Canada's governor-general; Paul-Emile Cardinal Leger, former archbishop of Montreal and now a missionary in Africa; and Dr. Frederick W. Minkler, recently retired as chairman of the board of education for the Toronto borough of North York.

The governor-general attended the ceremony.

Earlier in the day, the new five-storey central teaching building on the university campus was opened officially by Mrs. Michener, in a brief ceremony.

With the new building opened, construction has begun on another building for campus, a \$500,000 Student Centre, which adjoins the newest structure. The former student building will become a health centre and additional dining room space next year.
