Freeing of Curriculum Leads to
Changes in Faculty Sizes at WLU

Dr. Frank C. Peters, president of Waterloo Lutheran University, has announced that the change to greater choice for students in course offerings will result in several changes in department faculties next year.

In former years, students working for a B.A. degree at the university were required to take a great many compulsory courses, including a second language. A much more flexible curriculum was introduced two years ago in line with similar moves at other Ontario universities.

"Several courses, such as sociology and psychology, have enjoyed a great surge in enrolments and it is becoming evident that some areas will have decreased enrolments," he said.

"As a result, we will be adding faculty to some departments in order to provide a more satisfactory faculty-student ratio.

"This will mean that some contracts of junior faculty members teaching in departments where enrolments have been decreasing will not be renewed."
