Students With Awards, Prizes

Ten Ontario students who averaged 90 per cent or more in grade 13 and entered Waterloo Lutheran University will receive the university's Centennial Scholarships Thursday night at 8 p.m. during the presentation of entrance, undergraduate and graduate awards.

Receiving the scholarships are John Howard Butler, Waterloo; Kathryn Gail Carew, Orillia; Nora Ellen Elliot and David William McKinley of North Bay; Thomas Frederick Garner, Kitchener; Diane Elizabeth Lak, Alton; Penelope Catherine Rose, Streetsville; Christine Frances Sendall, Owen Sound; Margaret Ann Smith, Courtright; and Paul Frederick Sodtke of Port Colbourne.

Each scholarship has an annual value of free tuition and fees, free room and board and \$300 in cash. If the winning students maintain an 85 per cent average during their years at WLU, the total value would exceed \$6,500 each.

In addition, 95 WLU Faculty-Board Proficiency Scholarships will be awarded to students who entered the university this fall after achieving a 75 per cent standing in grade 13. The scholarships have an annual value of \$400.

Other prizes and awards include 32 proficiency scholarships awarded to grade 12 scholarship students who now have entered WLU, bypassing grade 13. - 30 -
