

It was replaced by the present mill In the year 1896 the little mill as it was called, was built by Coburn and Sons of Sturgeon falls, who operated it for some time, then sold to H.M. Brennan and Sons of Hamilton. They in turn sold to Shearer and Brown of Montreal The late James Mc Dougall of North Bay was their manager. In 1903 they sold to Geo. Gordon & Co.

The Sawmill of Geo. Gordon & Co. Ltd was burned in Sept. <sup>26<sup>th</sup></sup> 1951 and rebuilt in 1951-52 closed in 1965 Sold to Howland Lbr Co. Sturgeon Falls dismantled - 1967
