**NEW TRIER SWIMMERS**  
**TAKE INTERSCHOLASTIC**

**Victorious Over Evanston With 32 Points—Final Event Decided—Cardo Makes New Record.**

Coach Hyatt's New Trier High school swimmers captured the Purple interscholastic meet with 32 points. Evanston academy finished only one point behind the winners. The meet was undecided until the final event, the 100-yard swim, in which the Purple preps had two entries and needed seven points to tie New Trier, which had no one in the event. Rogers easily took first for the preps, but Johnson finished third, making a total of six points for the academy.

**New Trier Well Balanced.**

New Trier won because of a well balanced team rather than the individual efforts of stars. The north shore boys scored in every event with the exception of the 100-yard swim. Combs and Rogers of Evanston academy won individual honors, the latter piling up twelve points by swimming in the relay and taking firsts in the 40 and 100-yard swims, while Combs garnered eight points, besides breaking the record in the 220-yard swim. Cardo of New Trier established a new record in the 100-yard breast stroke by traveling the distance in 1:17½, against the old mark of 1:18, held by Vacine of Evanston High. Schaefer, New Trier's champion plunger, essayed to break the record of :24 4-5 in the plunge, but failed by one-fifth of a second.

**HELEN STAFFORD IS STAR OF THE INTERCLASS SWIM**

**Scores 19 Points in Six Events—Meet Won by Freshmen with Seniors Close Second—Juniors Third.**

Miss Helen Stafford of the class of 1920 was the star performer in the annual interclass swimming meet for girls at New Trier last Thursday afternoon. She scored 19 points, getting three firsts, one second, one fourth and swimming on the relay team. The freshmen won the meet with 62 points.
