Notice is hereby given to all persons interested that the Village of Winnetka, Cook County, Illinois, having ordered the improvement of the north side of Oak Street in front of the westerly eighty-five (85) feet of Lot Four (4), in front of Lot Three (3), an in front of the easterly forty-one (41) feet of Lot Two (2), all in Prouty's Homestead Subdivision; also the improvement of the southerly side of Oak Street, from the westerly gutter in Walnut Street to the present walk along the easterly side of Cedar Street, and from a line eighty-eight (88) feet westerly from and parallel with the westerly line of Maple Avenue to a line 440.5 feet westerly from and parallel with said westerly line of Maple Avenue, by the construction of a Portland cement concrete sidewalk five (5) feet four (4) inches in width, five (5) inches in thickness at the center and four (4) inches in thickness at the edges, laid on a bed of cinders, gravel or crushed concrete of an average thickness of four (4) inches; including all labor and materials, all in the Village of Winnetka, County of Cook and State of Illinois, the ordinance for the same being on file in the office of the Village Clerk of said Village, and the said Village having applied to the County Court of Cook County, Illinois, for a special assessment to pay the cost of said improvement according to the benefit, and an assessment therefor having been made and returned to said Court, Docket Number 279, the final hearing thereon will be held on the eighth day of September, A. D. 1919, or as soon there-

after as the business of the said Court will permit. All persons desiring may file objections in said Court before said day, and may appear on the hearing and make their defense. Said ordinance provides for the collection of said assessment in one payment, with interest thereon at the rate of five per centum (5%) per annum.

Notice is hereby given to all persons interested that the Village of Winnetka, Cook County, Illinois, having ordered the construction of a vitrified, glazed tile pipe sanitary sewer, including brick masonry manholes with cast iron covers and vitrified tile pipe junctions closed with vitrified tile discs, in Chestnut Street from and connecting with the present manhole in Chestnut Street at the south line extended west of Lot Nine (9) in Block Two (2) of Alles' First Addition to Winnetka, north in said Chestnut Street for a distance of nine hundred sixty (960) feet, all in the Village of Winnetka, County of Cook and State of

Illinois, the ordinance for the same being on file in the office of the Village Clerk of said Village, and the said Village having applied to the Superior Court of Cook County, Illinois, for a special assessment to pay the cost of said improvement according to the benefits, and an assessment therefor for having been made and returned to the said Court, General Number 346864, the final hearing thereon will be held on the eighth day of September, A.
