## Mothers to Watch Feeding of Pupils

North shore mothers will know what their children are eating at the North Shore Country Day school. Many parents who are planning to send their little folks to the new educational institution have expressed anxiety over the plan of feeding the children at the school. It is to allay any fears in that regard that Headmaster Perry Dunlap Smith announces that a mothers' committee has already been appointed by the trustees to assist in this department. Under the direction of Mrs. Edward K. Clark, chairman, a parent will be at the school daily to see what is on the bill of fare.

Miss Lila White, expert dietician, is to be in complete charge of the school lunchroom. Under her expert supervision the food is to be scientifically prepared insuring only the most wholesome food for the children.

Equipment of the Country Day school kitchen will entail the expenditure of approximately \$1,700, according to Mr. Smith. It is to be the most up to date "layout" available, with modern steam table and latest ranges.

Advance registrations at the school this week passed 150 in number and it was expected that the limit of 250 pupils would be reached and that many children would have to be turned away because of the restricted enrollment plan.
