## 2-CENT AND 15-CENT COINS ARE NOW IN DEMAND

Believing that 2-cent and 15-cent coins are needed, the National Association of Motion Picture Industry has succeeded in having two bills introduced in congress. Since the revenue tax on admissions went into effect the necessity for making change at the box office has occasioned an appreciable delay.

Other industries to be benefited will be newspapers, telephone and telegraph companies, soda fountains and candy stores and transportation lines. Motion picture men want a 15-cent coin because 15 cents is rapidly becoming the standard price of admission.

Boston, Mass., Dec. 13.—It is a foregone conclusion that a higher level of automobile prices will prevail by next spring, in fact, some increases are scheduled to be made by January 1 or prior to the New York Automobile Show.

Several prominent companies have already intimated to distributors that an increase would be made within thirty days, probably on the first of the year. Generally speaking a flat \$100 is the advance.

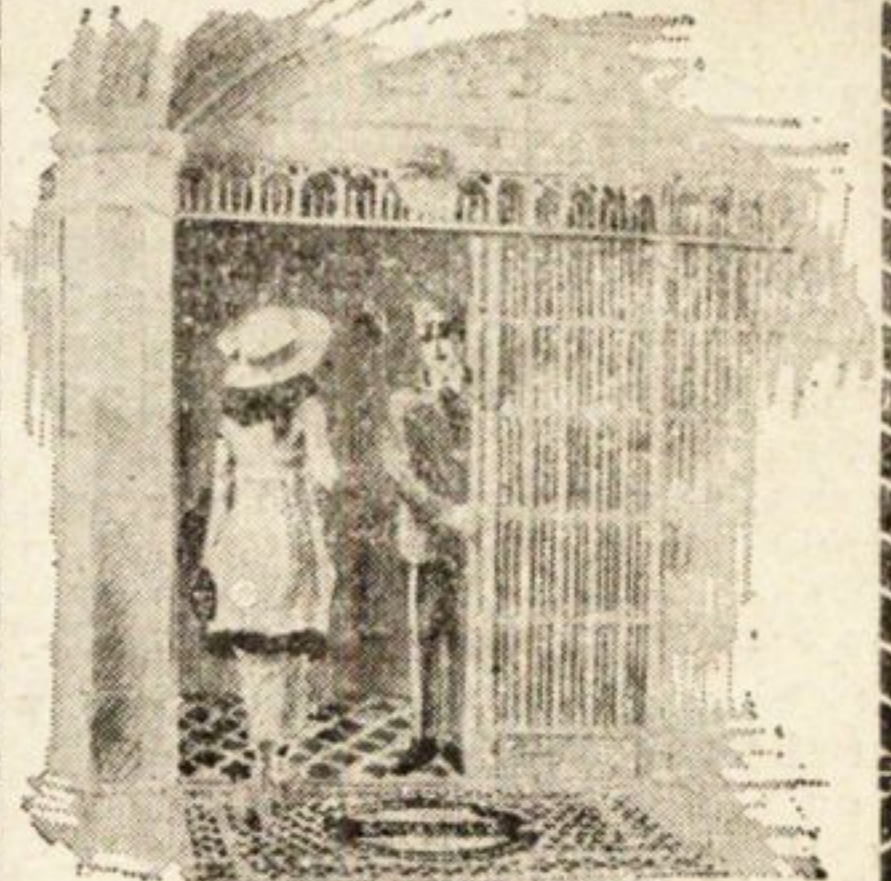

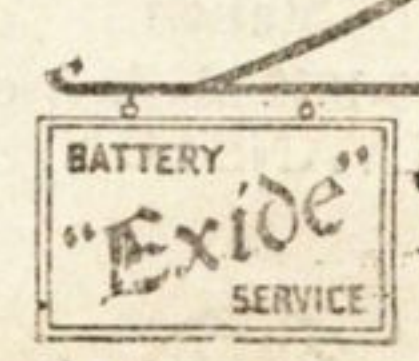
