

**A LECTURE
ON
CHRISTIAN SCIENCE**

Mr. William W. Porter, C. S. B., of New York City, member of the Board of Lectureship of The Mother Church, The First Church of Christ, Scientist, in Boston, Mass., delivered a lecture on Christian Science, Thursday evening, January 8th, under the auspices of First Church of Christ, Scientist, Wilmette, Ill., in the Church edifice, Central Avenue and Tenth street.

Mr. Charles L. Kirtland introduced the speaker. A synopsis of the evening's lecture follows:

Natural Development

The demonstration of Christian Science in the healing of the sick and the reconstruction of human thought on lines of right activity is to-day an accomplished and acknowledged fact. It is evident, in this connection, that if the existing systems of religion and medicine had been adequate to meet the needs and to satisfy the desires of mankind, no other system would ever have been necessary or even possible.

Orthodoxy

The objection is sometimes made that Christian Science is not orthodox. This brings up the question of what is, and what is not orthodox. Human opinions combine in a statement of belief, and then declare that those who differ from beliefs thus stated are unorthodox. The amount of this is: If you believe as we do, you are orthodox. If you do not believe as we do, then you are decidedly unorthodox, and—"do not believe in the divinity of Christ."

That alone is orthodox which, proceeding from Principle, Truth or God, brings out the fruits of health and righteousness. This is the work Christian Science is accomplishing.

The World War

The activities of Christian Scientists during the world war recently

closed are well known. Christian Scientists have been a unit in their support of the policies of our government and its allies. As the atmosphere of peace and justice settles over the nations of the world Christian Scientists recognize that the victory has not been so much a victory of men over men, or nations over nations, but is a victory of Principle and Truth over the rulers of the darkness of this world, and over spiritual wickedness in high places, as Paul puts it.

Gratitude To Mrs. Eddy

Christian Scientists have a tender regard and gratitude for their revered Leader, Mary Baker Eddy. This gratitude is in recognition and acknowledgment of the broad, unselfish service to mankind which characterized Mrs. Eddy's life. From the time of her healing in the year 1866, Mrs. Eddy's life was spent consistently and exclusively in unfolding the facts connected with her healing in such terms and manner as would best be understood by the human mind.

The Christian Science Textbook

The recognition is growing that the works of Christian Science reflect the existence of a definite law, and that this law is available to heal and bless all mankind. The statement of this law, or Christian Science, and the method of application will be found in all of the writings of Mrs. Eddy, more especially in the book "Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures," which is the only textbook on Christian Science healing. This book is unfolding to mankind the true idea of Causation or God, in a higher idea of life, more adequate health, courage, confidence, ability, righteousness, and good will. These

are the fruits of Christian Science, the sign of Immanuel, or "God with us." If God, the one eternal Mind or Causation, be with you here and now,

School Problems**

The following questions received this week are answered by Superintendent C. W. Washburne.

Q. Why are the children in the upper grades doing so much primary arithmetic?

A. The fundamental processes of

addition, subtraction, multiplication and division must be thoroughly mastered before a pupil can do more advanced problems accurately. The great bulk of arithmetic done by most of us in everyday life consists of these fundamental operations with whole numbers. Such work as we have to do in fractions, decimals and percentage will be accurate in exact proportion to the accuracy of our work with whole numbers. A large proportion of the upper grade children in the Winnetka Public
