SUGAR IS STILL USED AS POSTAGE "STICKUM"

"Stickum" which the Government puts on postage stamps still is sweetened despite the high price of sugar. Director Wilmeth of the Bureau of Printing and Engraving, said today, in response to complaints of some postoffice customers that stamps taste bitter.

"We use ten gallons of corn syrup each day in preparing 'stickum', said Wilmeth. "The proportion has not been changed in years.

"Cassava Dextrine, imported from Java, forms the basis for the mixture. It is a yellow powder which in itself possesses a slight sweet taste. Nobody need fear licking the Government's stamps. The 'stickum' used is clean and also slightly nutritious."

BOLSHEVIK ARMY 440,000

For the first time here figures of the strength of bolshevik and anti-bolshevik armies in Russia were made public this week.

The figures of the bolshevik armies and their opponents on the various fronts are as follows: North front, bolshevik 25,500, anti-bolshevik 20,200; west front, bolshevik 125,000, foe 137,000; south front, bolshevik 215,000, foe 165,000; east front, bolshevik 75,000, foe 130,000.

In addition to these armies, numbering 440,000, the bolsheviks have a reserve force of 250,000 men.


