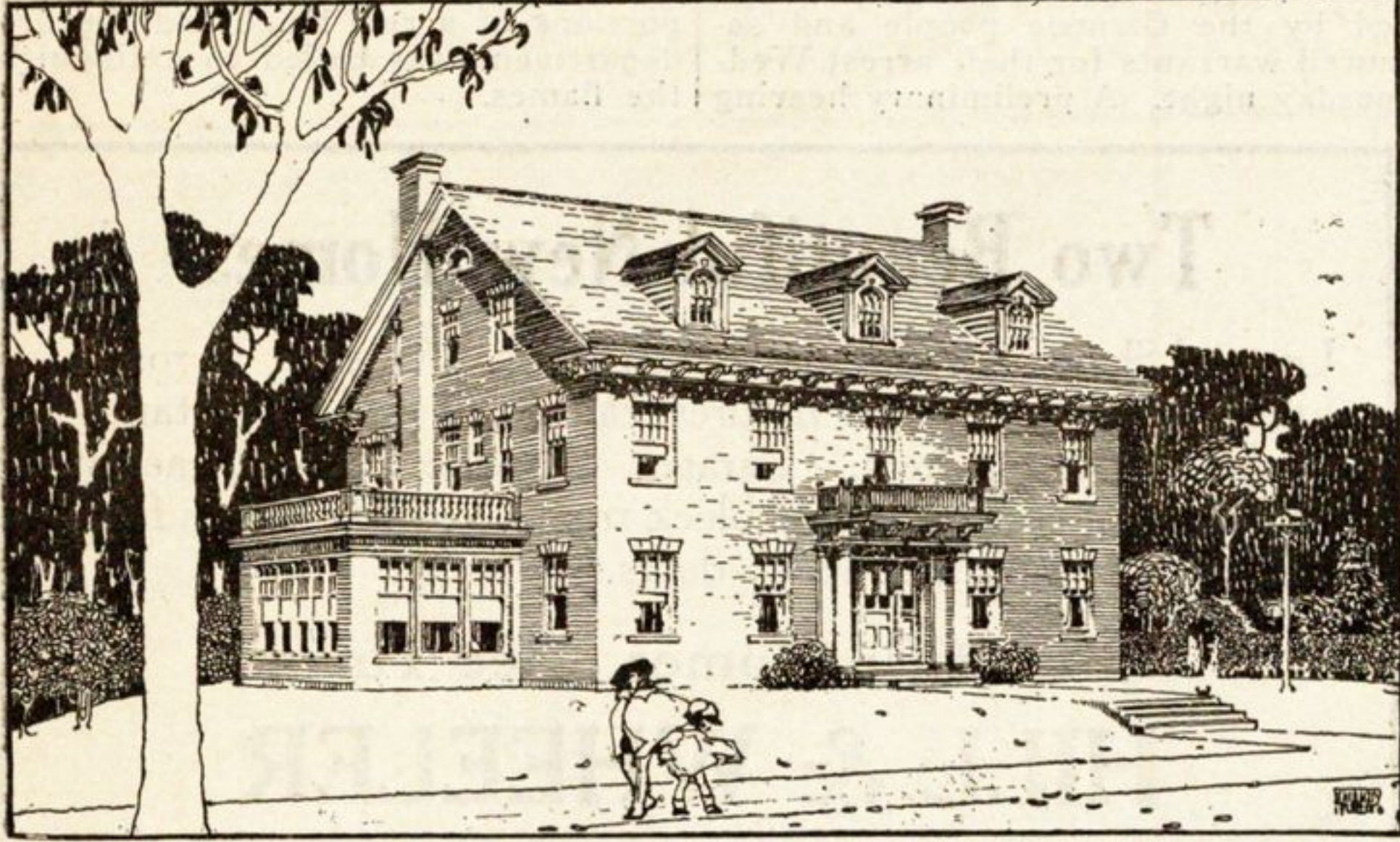


Beautiful Home in Newest Subdivision
