FRENCH WAR LOSSES

What is the first comprehensive statement of France's war losses has just been made by Capt. Andre Tardieu, former French high commissioner in the United States. In describing what he calls the "balance sheet" of France, Capt. Tardieu states that during the five years of war 8,000,000 men were mobilized, of whom 1,400,000 were killed and 800,000 maimed. France lost 57 per cent of her men under 32 years of age.

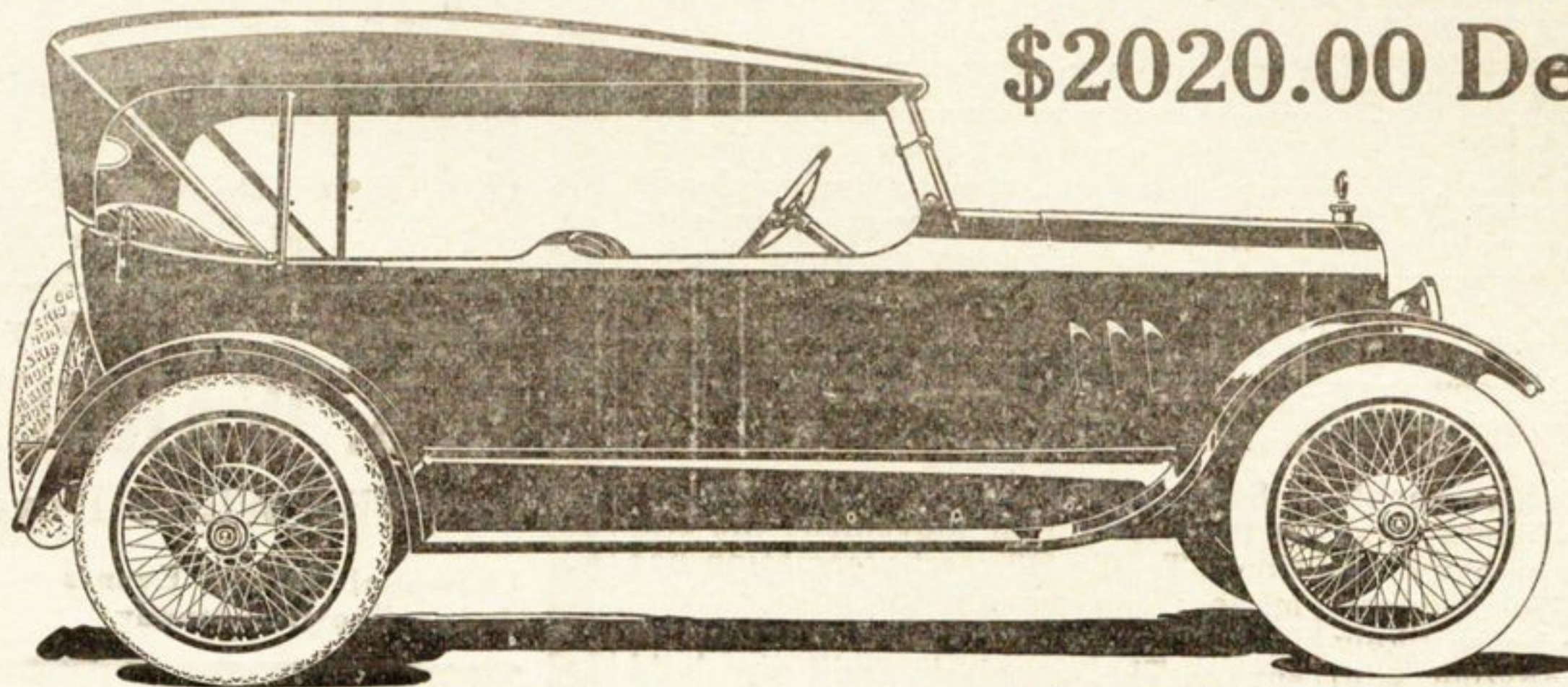

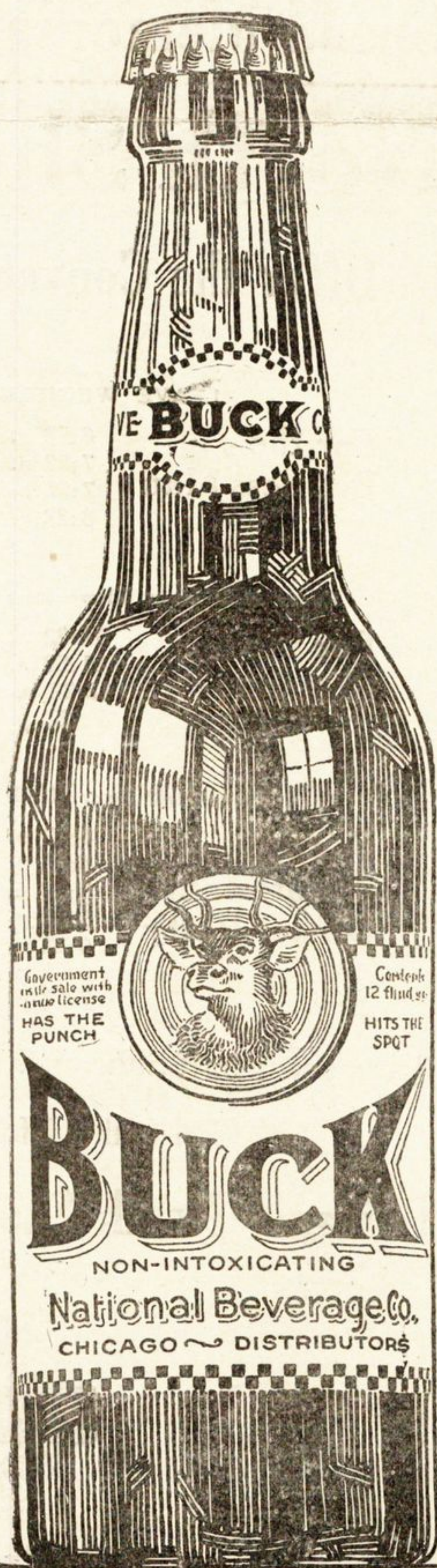
