Funds Forthcoming for Erection of New Clubhouse On Site of Structure Destroyed by Flames Friday Night

USE ASSESSMENT PLAN?

Consider Building With Bond Issue and by Means of Special Assessments on Members

secretary this week for a regular the kitchen, has been electric lighted meeting of the members of the club on June 14 at the clubhouse of the Evanston club for the purpose of formally authorizing the issuance of \$200,000 to \$250,000 in bonds, or to arrange for other methods of financing the undertaking.

#### Will Have Assessments

The balance of the cost of the building, if it does cost more than \$250,000, and the cost of the furnishings will probably be raised by an assessment among the members. This plan is suggested in order to make the new issue of bonds absolutely good. The club will realize \$60,000 in insurance on the clubhouse and \$24,000 on the contents, a total of \$84,000.

Approximately \$40,000 worth of bonds on the old structure were outstanding at the time of the fire, so that there now remains in the treasury of the club, as a nucleus toward the new building, something more than \$40,000.

This is in excess of any cash surplus which may have been in possession of the club treasurer at the time the fire occurred. The appointment of a building committee has already been authorized and it is understood that several architects will be asked immediately to prepare and submit plans for the new building to this committee.

#### Will Meet June 14

At the meeting on the 14th the club members will discuss the idea of financing the new building through special assessment among the mebers, and also by a series of monthly dues of approximately \$25 a month in excess of the present dues, to be continued until the improvements have been paid for. If this plan is followed there will be no issue of bonds.

The old bonds on the burned clubhouse have been called for payment July 1. Payment will be made from the proceeds of insurance and the club will then be free from mortgage debt.

Proxies have been sent out with the call for the meeting on the 14th, which indicate the following propositions, will be considered:

(a) A proposed bond issue for the purpose of erecting a new clubhouse and necessary buildings, if any, supplementary thereto.

(b) Fixing a rate of dues and membership admission fees advisable to cover the additional requirements. (c) To consider and if deemed ad-

visable, adopt a plan for financing the reconstruction of the necessary buildings by special assessment upon the members.

(d) To consider and adopt any and all measures necessary or convenient for the construction of said building or buildings; meeting the financial


