Notice is hereby given to all persons interested that the Village of Winnetka, Cook County, Illinois, having ordered the improvement of Burr Avenue from and connecting with the present water pipe at the southerly line extended easterly of Laurel Avenue, southerly to a point twenty-six (26) feet south of the north line extended east of Fig Street; also the improvement of Fig Street from said proposed water pipe in Burr Avenue west in said Fig Street one hundred eighty (180) feet; also the improvement of the private road or easement provided therefor running northerly and southerly through Skokie View Subdivision from and connecting with said proposed water pipe in Fig Street to and connecting with the present water pipe in Pine Street, by the construction in said private road or easement provided thereof of a ten (10) inch internal diameter cast iron water pipe; also the improvement of Fig Street from and connecting with the present water pipe in Linden Avenue west to and connecting with the present water pipe in Rosewood Avenue; also the improvement of Rosewood Avenue from and connecting with the present water pipe in Fig Street, south in Rosewood Avenue to and connecting with the present water pipe in Pine Street; also the improvement of Ely Road from and connecting with the water pipe herein proposed to be laid in Rosewood Avenue east in Ely Road to a point twenty-six (26) feet east of the west line extended of Locust Street; also the improvement of Locust Street from and connecting with the water pipe herein proposed to be laid in Ely Road south in said Locust Street to a point twenty-six (26) feet south of the north line extended of Starr Road; also the improvement of Starr Road from and connecting with the water pipe herein proposed to be laid in Locust Street, west in said Starr Road to and connecting with the water pipe herein proposed to be laid in Rosewood Avenue; also the improvement of the private road or easement provided therefor running easterly and westerly in said Skokie View Subdivision from and connecting with the water pipe herein proposed to be laid in Rosewood Avenue westerly in said private road or easement to and connecting with the water pipe herein proposed to be laid in the northerly and southerly private road or easement provided therefor in said Skokie View Subdivision, thence westerly in said easterly and westerly private road or easement from and connecting with the water pipe herein proposed to be laid in the northerly and southerly private road or easement in said Skokie View Subdivision west in said easterly

westerly private road or easement to the west end of said easterly and westerly private road or easement by the construction in the said Fig Street, Rosewood Avenue, Ely Road, Locust Street, Starr Road and easterly and westerly private road or easement in said Skokie View Subdivision of a six (6) inch internal diameter cast iron water pipe, including all cast iron water pipe, cast iron water pipe fittings, cast iron body bronze mounted fire hydrants with cast iron body and bronze mounted auxiliary water gate valves with cast iron shut off boxes with lids, cast iron body bronze mounted water gate valves, brick masonry water gate valve vaults with cast iron covers, connections of cast iron water pipe with necessary cast iron water pipe fittings for proposed water pipe to present water mains, and engineer-

ing and supervision during construction, all in the Village of Winnetka, County of Cook and State of Illinois, the ordinance for the same being on file in the office of the Village Clerk of said village, and the said village having applied to the Superior Court of Cook County, Illinois, for an assessment of the cost of said improvement according to the benefits, and an assessment therefor having been made and returned to said Court, General Number 355173, the final hearing thereon will be held on the twenty-eighth day of June, A. D. 1920, or as soon thereafter as the business of the said Court may permit. All persons desiring may file objections in said Court before said day, and may appear on the hearing and make their defense. Said ordinance provides for the collection of said assessment in ten (10) annual installments with interest there-

on at the rate of five per centum (5%) per annum.

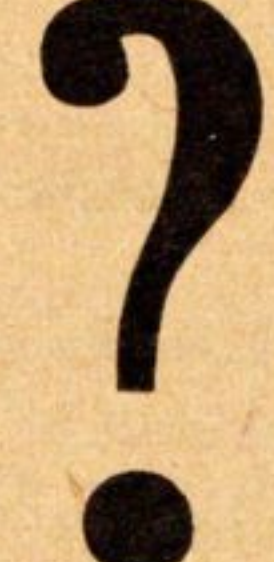
