

**COMMERCIAL MEN  
DETERMINED UPON  
"BIGGER OUTLOOK"**

Renewed life and a "bigger outlook" are to characterize future activity of the New Trier Commercial association if plans of directors, now in the formative stage, materialize. Indications are the association of north shore business men will enter upon the biggest year of its history with the opening of new business this fall.

Whereas the Commercial association has in the past emphasized the strictly business element of its activity, it is the avowed purpose of President Henry B. Gates and the board of directors to include in the affairs and aims of the organization something of Community interest, something broader than the mere "collection of bad debts," to serve effectively all the villages coming within its sphere of influence, to work for good government in the township, endorse and actively support every movement having as its purpose the furtherance of civic expend diligent effort in acquainting the "outside world" with the particular advantages of the north shore as an exclusive residence and high grade business section.

In this connection it may be stated that the association aims to bring to the north shore speakers of wide repute to address public gatherings of the residents of the township. These public meetings are to be held in the interest of stimulating community spirit and to bring about a closer relationship among the residents of the township.

The association hopes, also, to cooperate with township officials and organizations in effecting feasible methods of promoting township improvements particularly in regard to improvement of highways and beautification of certain territories lying in the township and outside the jurisdiction of the villages.

The first public meeting is to be arranged for early in the fall, it is announced, while other important events are to be made public from time to time.

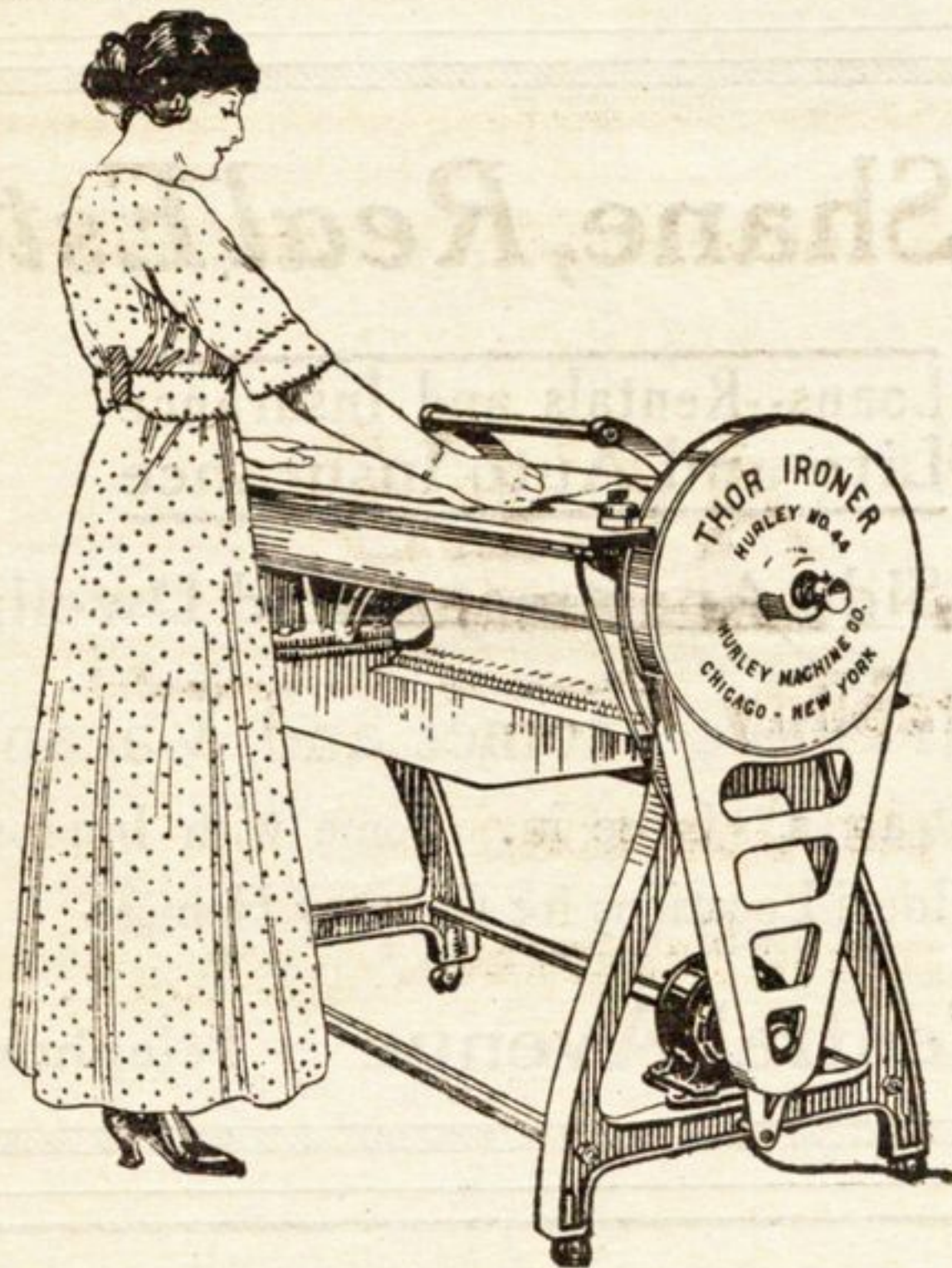

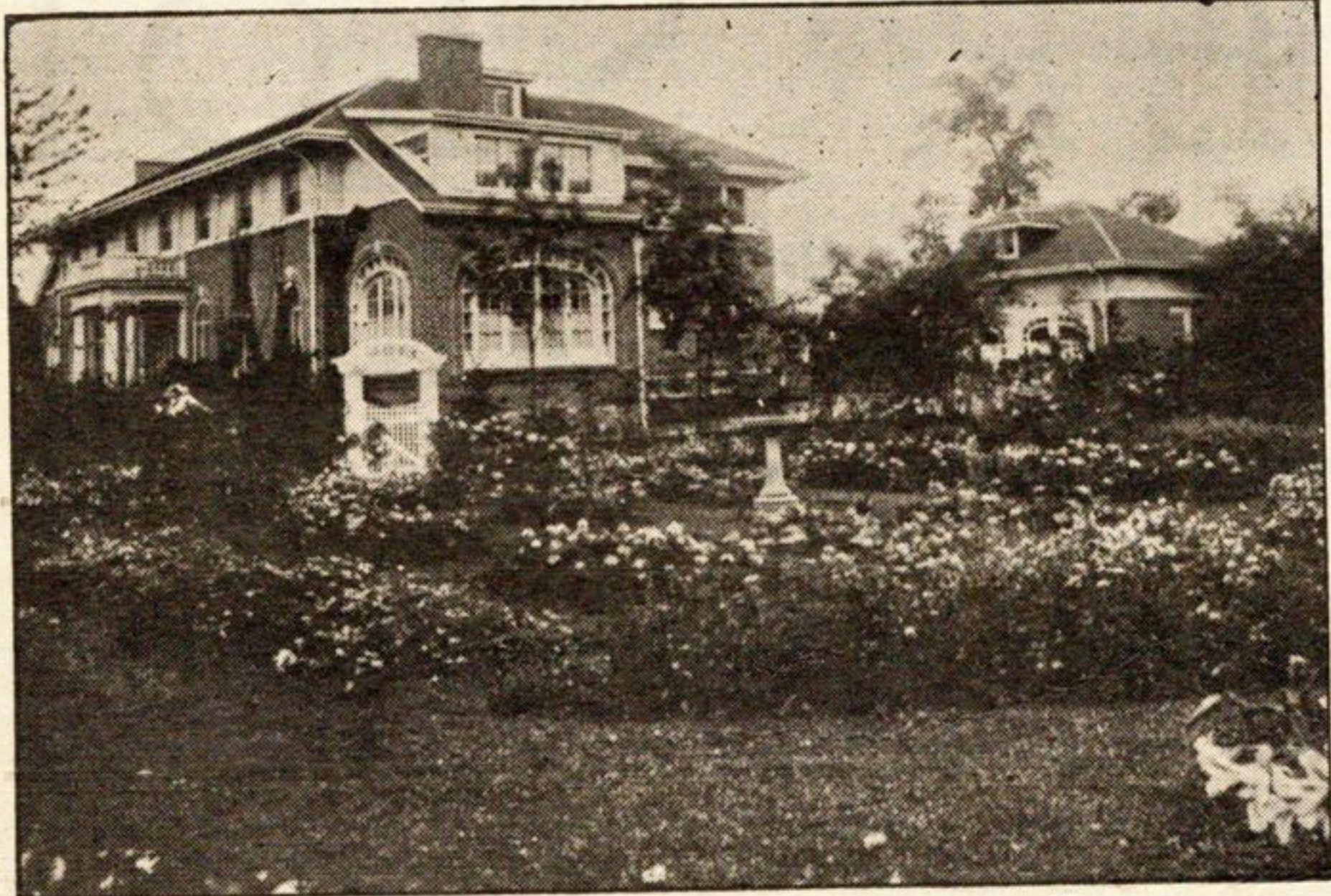
