Oglesby Sentiment Is Growing Steadily

Cook County Residents Arise to Fight Thompsonism, Leaders Claim

"If there has been any question for two weeks about the nomination of John G. Oglesby for governor it was dissipated by the registration on last Wednesday."

"The recent reports coming out from Chicago are to the effect that the citizens there are going to take this opportunity of shaking off the hard tribute-levying rule of the Tammany machine."
