

CANDIDATE FOR U. S. SENATE IS VETERAN OF THE WORLD WAR

Illinois is offered the services of a veteran of the World War to represent the state in the United States senate in the candidacy at the Republican primaries of Tuesday, September 15, of Burnett M. Chipfield of Canton, Ill.

Mr. Chipfield was born in Dover, Bureau County, Ill., and was educated in the schools of the state.

He is a trial lawyer by profession and first came prominently before the public as city attorney of Canton. Later he was States Attorney of Fulton County. In his legal activities Mr. Chipfield has been president of the State's Attorneys association of Illinois and president of the American Society of Military Law. He is a member of the Illinois Bar association and the American Bar association.

He was a member of the Illinois Legislature for 8 years, displaying keen interest in agricultural, educational, humanitarian measures and laws looking toward improvement of labor conditions.

He was a Congressman at large from Illinois in the House of Representatives.

In 1917 and at the outbreak of the war he was a candidate for nomination for United States Senator. He

recalled his candidacy to enter the United States army. Soon after he was appointed assistant to General Crowder. He was promoted to the rank of Lieutenant Colonel for his splendid services in that department of the service.

Following the Armistice Lieut. Col. Chipfield was ordered to Germany with the Army of Occupation, attached to the 3rd Army Corps. Here again he rendered exceptional service to his country and was the recipient of numerous citations coming from General Pershing and other army leaders. He received his honorable discharge in 1919. He is a member of the American Legion Post No. 16.

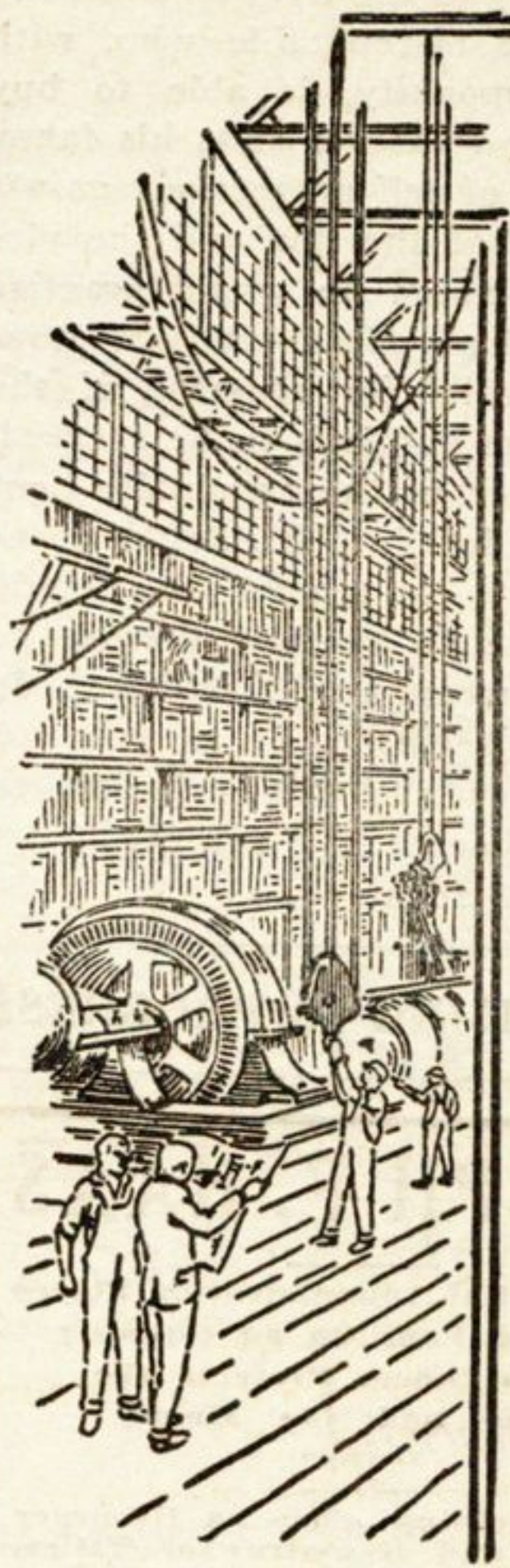

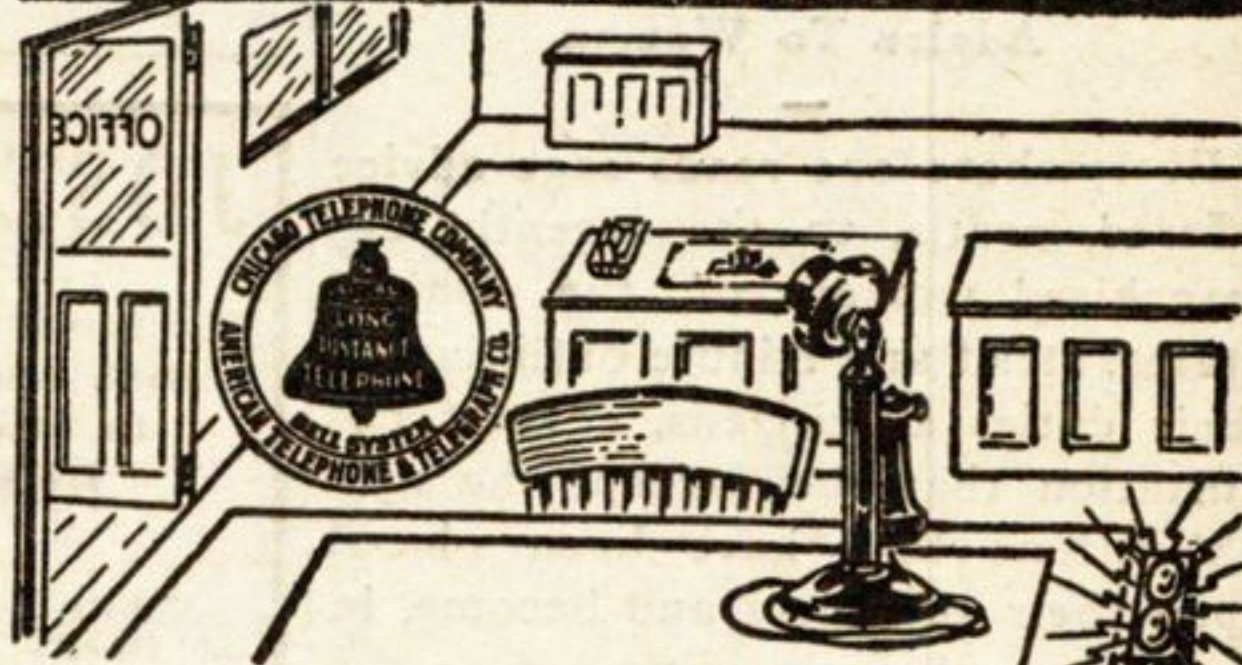
"They Don't Answer"
