## INDIANS DEFEAT REDS IN INDOOR THRILLER

INDIANS DEFEAT REDS .....

Redskinned Warriors Come From Behind To Win 9-4 Argument; Now Lead League by Two full Games

The Indians took a firm grip on first place in the Winnetka Indoor Baseball league at the Community House Wednesday evening by trouncing the Reds 9 to 4 while the Dodgers won their initial victory by defeating the Cubs 13 to 11.

The first game began like a whirlwind, the Reds holding a 3 to 0 lead until the fourth inning when the forward batteries of the Redskins opened up and sent a trio of counters over the plate. A serious mistake was perpetrated by the Reds at this stage. Kreger, who usually catches Lucchesi, was in the box and was hitting on "all four" holding the enemy fine when Lucchesi came on the scene and without warming up was sent to the box. The result, he lacked control and pitched himself into serious holes at the beginning of each stanza eventually losing the game.

### Passes Prove Fatal

Kreger, first to bat in the first inning, reached the initial sack on a dropped third strike and went to second on Stordeur's hit. A passed ball allowed them both to advance a base from where they counted on Runnfeldt's single. The Reds scored again in the third on Ilg's one-base blow followed by blows by Ulbrecht and Runnfeldt.

The Indians failed to register until the fourth when with one down Kassner doubled to center and reached home on Voltz's hit through second. Deily hit safely sending Voltz to third himself going to second on the first pitched ball. Ulbrecht

dropped a pitched ball allowing Voltz to count and when the receiver threw wild to third Deily also reached home.

### Reds To Front

The Reds forged ahead in the fifth when Runnfeldt, who had connected for one sack, stole second and rode home on Blow's clout to right.

The Indians were not to be beaten, however, and immediately tied it up Dietz's single and Kassner's second double. The Reds failed to score another marker while their opponents scored another run in the sixth, one in the seventh and three in the eighth.

### Lop-sided Affair

The second game was a one-sided affair after the fourth inning until the final spasm when the Bruins rallied to the extent of six runs. Not much credit can be given to the visitors as the Cubs had only five men on the floor and at one time
