The following mandates are now operative under the treaty of Versailles:

- Great Britain over German East Africa, 384,000 square miles.
- Great Britain over Palestine west of the Jordan, 9,000 square miles.
- Great Britain over Mesopotamia, 250,000 square miles.
- The Union of South Africa over German Southwest Africa, 322,000 square miles.
- France over German Cameroons in Africa, 269,759 square miles.
- France over part of German Togoland, 106,740 square miles.
- Australia over New Britain, Kaiser Wilhelm Land and German islands south of the equator.
- New Zealand over German Samoa.
- Japan over the Marshall, Caroline, Pelew, Ladron and other islands north of the equator.

**FORDSON TRACTOR  
IN RECORD RUN  
IN NORTH DAKOTA**


Stopping only for gasoline and oil, a Fordson tractor owned by N. Korpua of Ludden, Dickey county, N. D., recently completed a record run of forty days. Three operators were assigned to the tractor, each working an eight hour shift and thus keeping the tractor in operation twenty-four hours a day. "Nine hundred acres were plowed without one minute's stop for repairs," says the affidavit received by the Ford company from the Fordson owner.

The tractor was purchased during the summer of 1919. In the spring of 1920 Korpua began his plowing and had already turned 200 acres before he conceived the idea of working the

tractor day and night. Electric headlights were installed, operators were obtained, and with no further preparations the little Fordson entered upon what turned out to be a record run for endurance.

WHEN fifteen telephones are added on a street on which there are 100 telephone users, an additional distribution cable may be necessary.


When the same thing happens on six or eight nearby streets, served from the same cable terminal, there must be new main cables from terminal boxes to the exchange.

Such increases from several localities soon call for additions to switchboard and terminal room facilities.

Finally a new exchange, with its costly equipment, must be built, and extensive re-distribution made of the outside plant.

These are some of the elements which enter into the cost of supplying telephone service to growing communities.
