CONNECTING NATIONAL PARKS

(Portland Oregonian.)

The delights of seeing America first will be greatly enhanced if the program of the National Park-to-Park Highway association, which met recently in Denver, is carried out. The organization is seeking federal co-operation with the states in a plan to build highways connecting Mesa Verde, Rocky Mountain, Yellowstone, Glacier, Mount Rainer, Lassen, Yosemite, Crater Lake and other parks, thus making them accessible to everyone of the more than 10,000,000 automobile owners in the United States. It is estimated that 5,600 miles of road will be required, part of which will be included in state programs already under way. Plea for federal aid is based on the theory that the government created the parks for enjoyment of all the people and that it is as important to have access to them as to create them in the first instance. It is a consumma-

tion to look forward to, however much it may be embarrassed for the present by demand for economy in national affairs.




