The guests of honor were the president of Wellesley college, Miss Ellen Fitz Pendleton, and the president of the board of trustees, Edwin Parnham Green, who is a prominent Boston engineer, and vice president of the American Woolen company.

President Pendleton and Mr. Green came on from Boston especially to be present at this meeting, which launched in Illinois the campaign for funds that Wellesley is to make in the next few months.

Following the example of other eastern colleges, the alumnae of Wellesley are anxious to increase the salaries of the teaching force of the college. By the commencement of June, 1921, the alumnae expect to raise \$2,000,000 for salary endowment, and in addition to this \$700,000 for new buildings.

There are in Illinois some 500 Wellesley women who are to be organized in working groups.

Friday, January 21, is Philanthropy Day at the Wilmette Woman's club. Luncheon will be served.

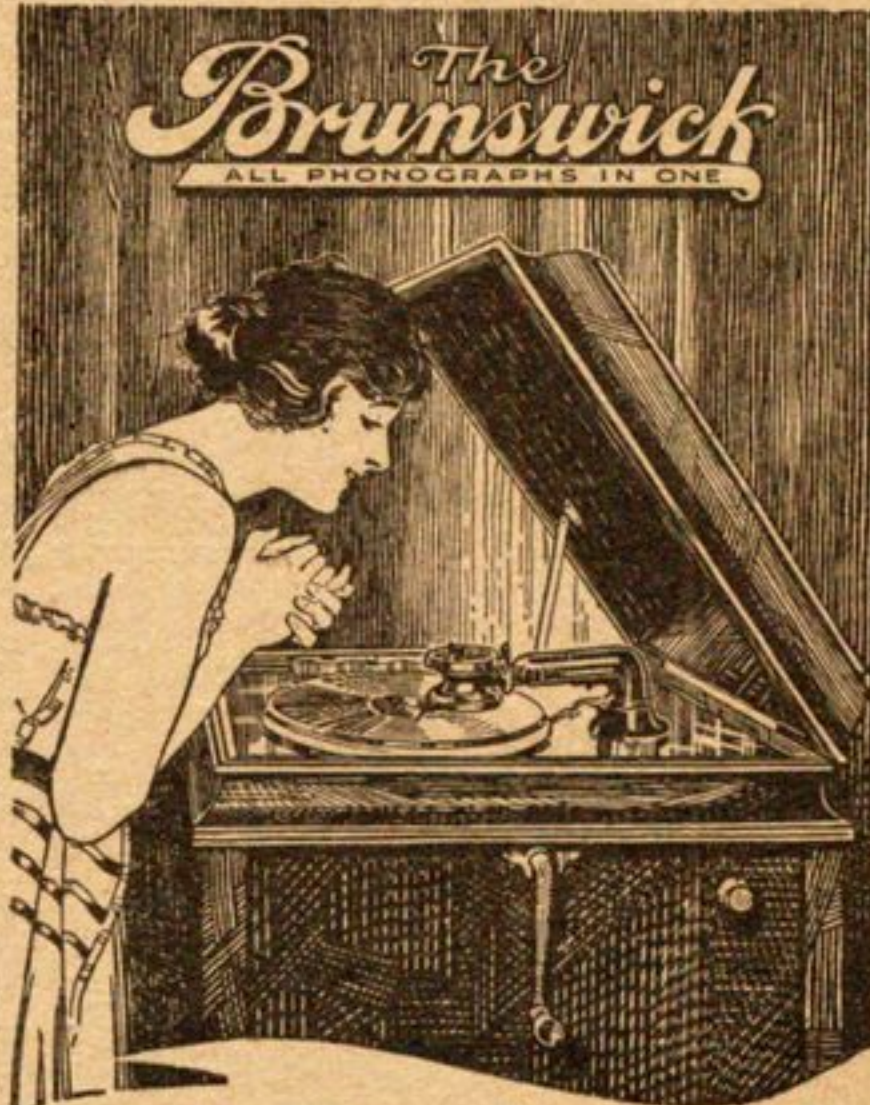
