

**LEGION MEMBERSHIP
AT YEAR'S BEGINNING
DOUBLE THAT OF 1920**

The American Legion entered the year 1921 with twice as many members and 3,417 more posts than it had January 1, 1920, according to official records at National headquarters at Indianapolis. In even greater ratio was the gain of the Women's Auxiliary, which started the year with fifty units and 5,000 members and finished with 1,695 units and a total of approximately 200,000 members.

The unusual increase in Legion posts was characteristic of every state department and likewise in the overseas departments, where there is apparently small chance for expansion. New posts were formed in the following foreign countries: Argentine, 1; Chile, 1; China, 1; Guatemala, 1; Japan, 2; Poland, 2; Samoa, 1; Santo Domingo 1; Peru, 1.

Prospects for further growth of both organizations are bright, in that membership campaigns started with the New Year in many states. The six leading Legion departments, in

regard to membership, are: New York, Pennsylvania, Illinois, Iowa, Ohio and Minnesota. The list of Auxiliary units is headed by Massachusetts, followed by Minnesota, Illinois and New York.

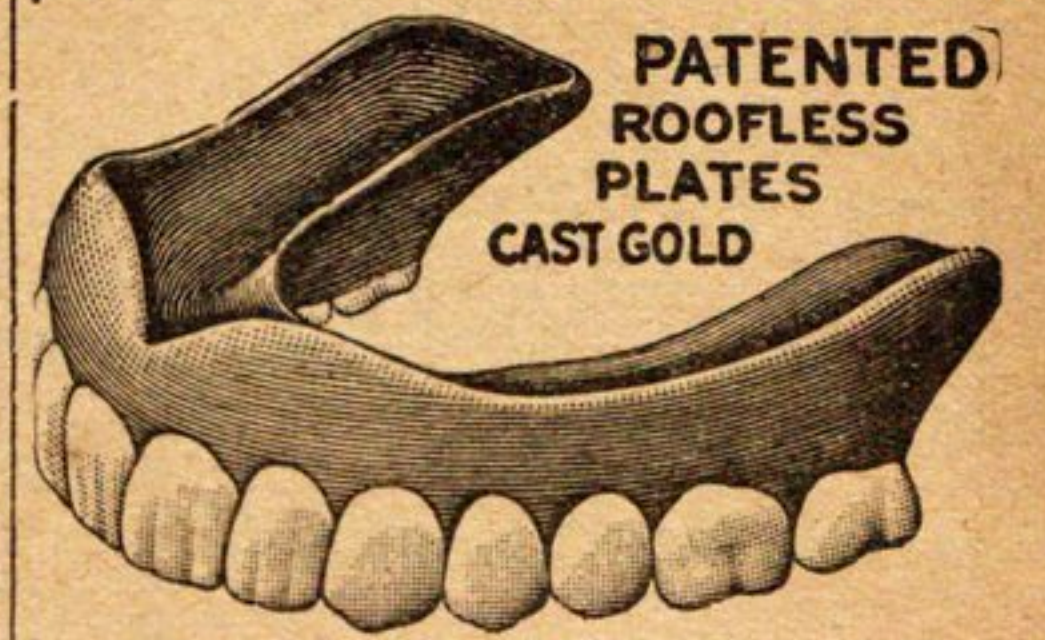
