

THRIFT METERS FOR

Burton Holmes Travelogues to be Treasury Plan Stimulates Helpful Rivalry; Ask Special Instructions In Thrift.

Thrift meters are being introduced into all the schools of the Seventh Federal Reserve district, comprising Owing to the usual amplifications | the states of Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Michigan and Wisconsin, by the Savings division of the U.S. Treasury department. According to reports received by the Chicago office at 105 West Monroe street, the schools that have already received them show a marked increase in saving.

Under the new Treasury plan each teacher divides the class or room into two teams, the girls taking the name of Miss Columbias team, the boys that of Uncle Sam's team. Their progress is recorded weekly on the Thrift meter, which registers up to \$30 for each team. The goal for each pupil usually is one or more Thrift stamps a week.

Superintendents and principals have instructed teachers to enter into the spirit of thrift instruction and push it in a manner that will produce results. They want this year to show marked advancement in establishing among school children habits of thrift in time, money and materials. The helpful rivalry stimulated by the Thrift meters is expected to contribute largely to the success of the movement.



HAVE YOU SEEN "PEP"? HE STRAYED AWAY AGAIN


Have you seen "Pep"?
