NEW TRIER TROUNCES LA GRANGE IN BASKETBALL

North Shore Athletes Trim Lyons Township Fives Decisively at New Trier; Kershaw Stars

New Trier High school cage artists settled the dispute Tuesday afternoon at New Trier High school regarding the superiority of La Grange. The north shore heavyweights won in easy fashion 26 to 11 while the lightweights' victory was more decisive. Final score, New Trier 36; La Grange 13.

The lightweight encounter was a tight affair during the first quarter but in the second frame the home players began to edge away from the Lyons township athletes. At the end of the third quarter the New Trier victory was assured.

Kershaw was the main factor in the lightweight win. Six baskets and four free throws were netted by him, and several of his markers were baskets caged from the center of the floor. Rand's usual stellar playing was in evidence. Smith and Boice kept the visiting forwards well under cover throughout with the result that many attacks were frustrated.

Parker in Limelight

The heavyweight combat was slow and uninteresting during the first ten minutes of play. In the second session the New Trier forward batteries opened, the score at half time being 14-3. In the second half the New Trierites lengthened their lead to a substantial margin and La Grange was unable to check the offensive. Varney and Parker scintillated in the more important tussle. Parker only made one basket but after Varney demonstrated that his eye for making free throws was nil he was called upon to take the advantage of La Grange's continual rough tactics. Eight free throws were registered by the New Trier guard.
