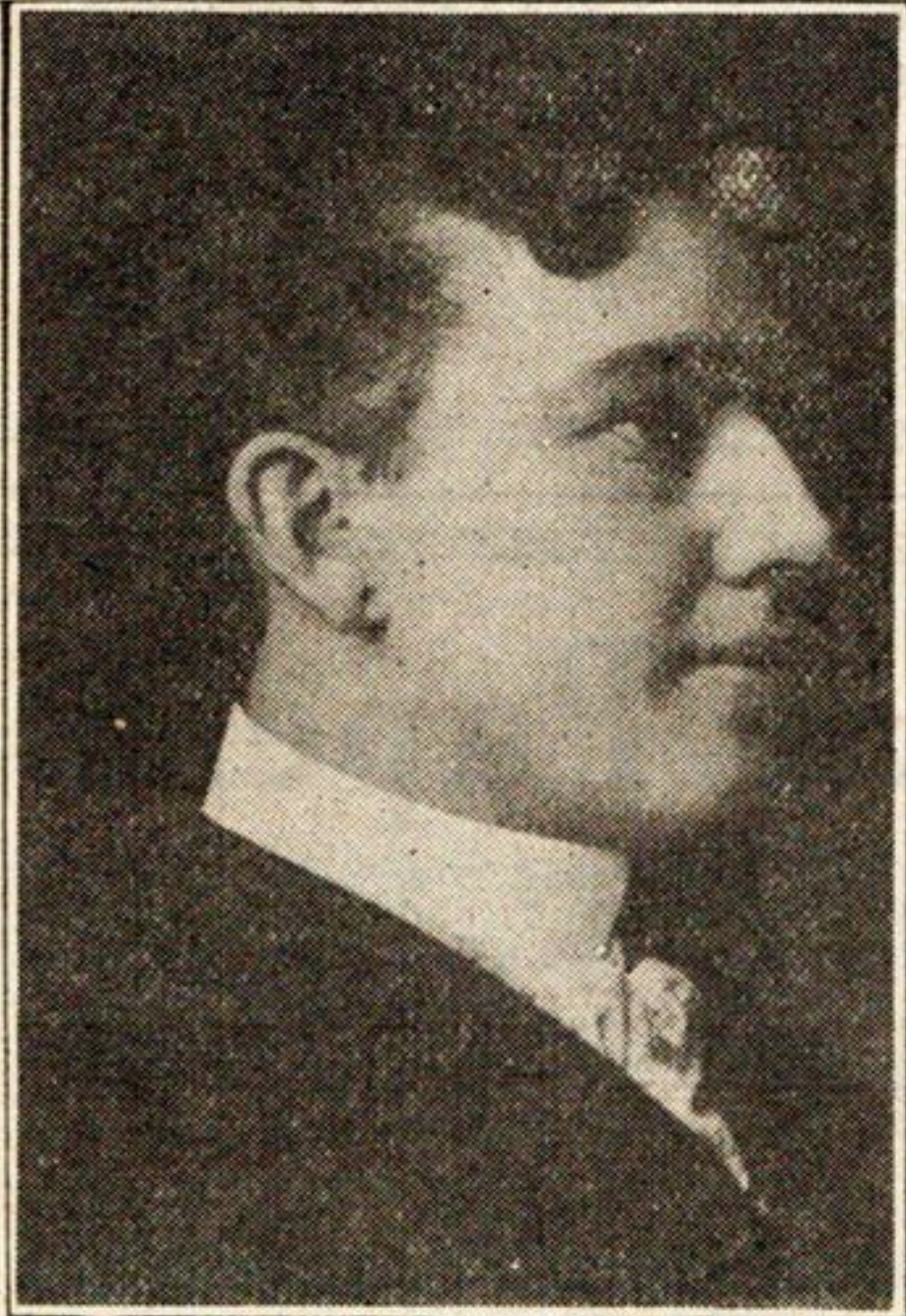


CONSIDERATE SERVICE THIS MAN'S MOTTO

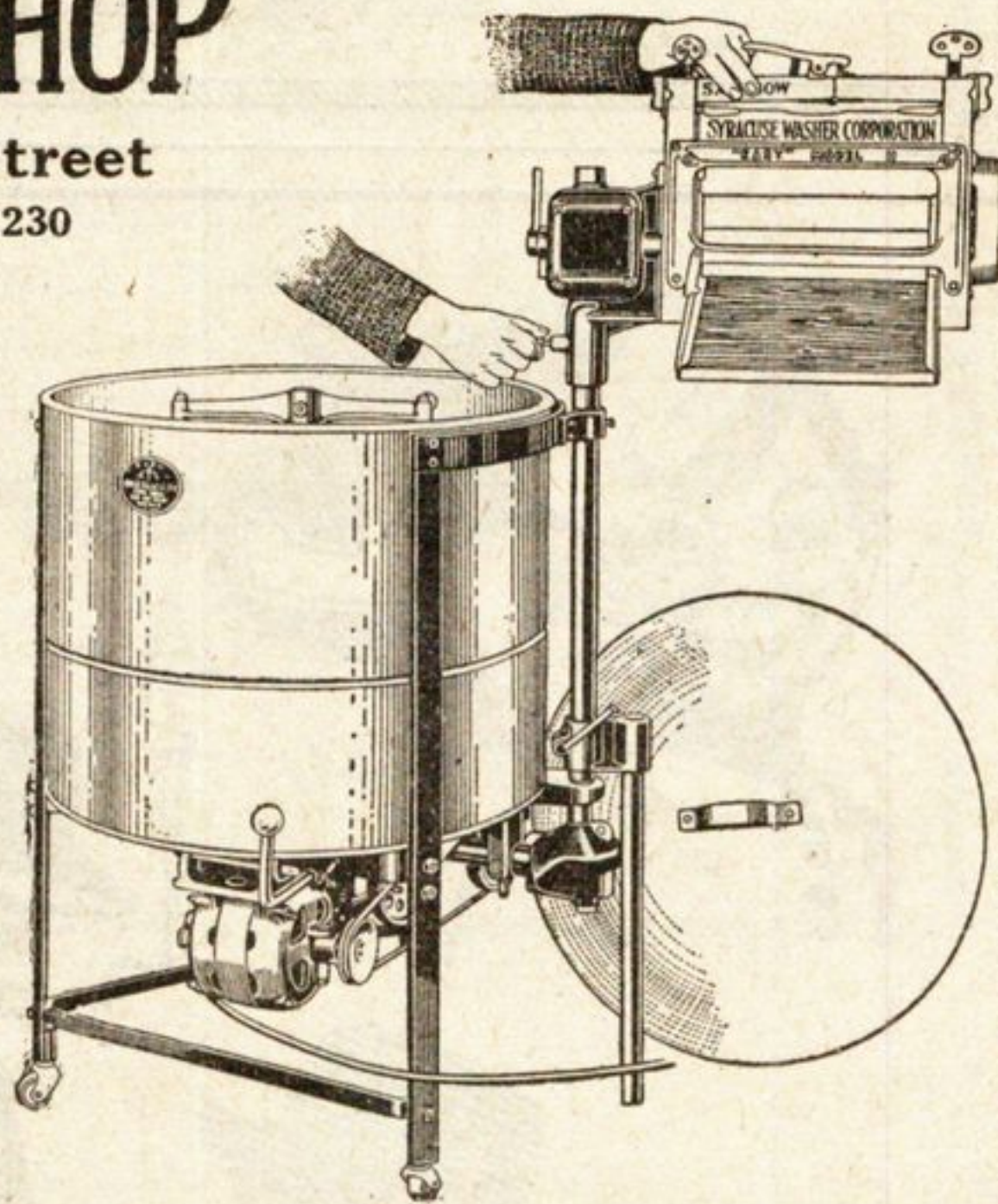

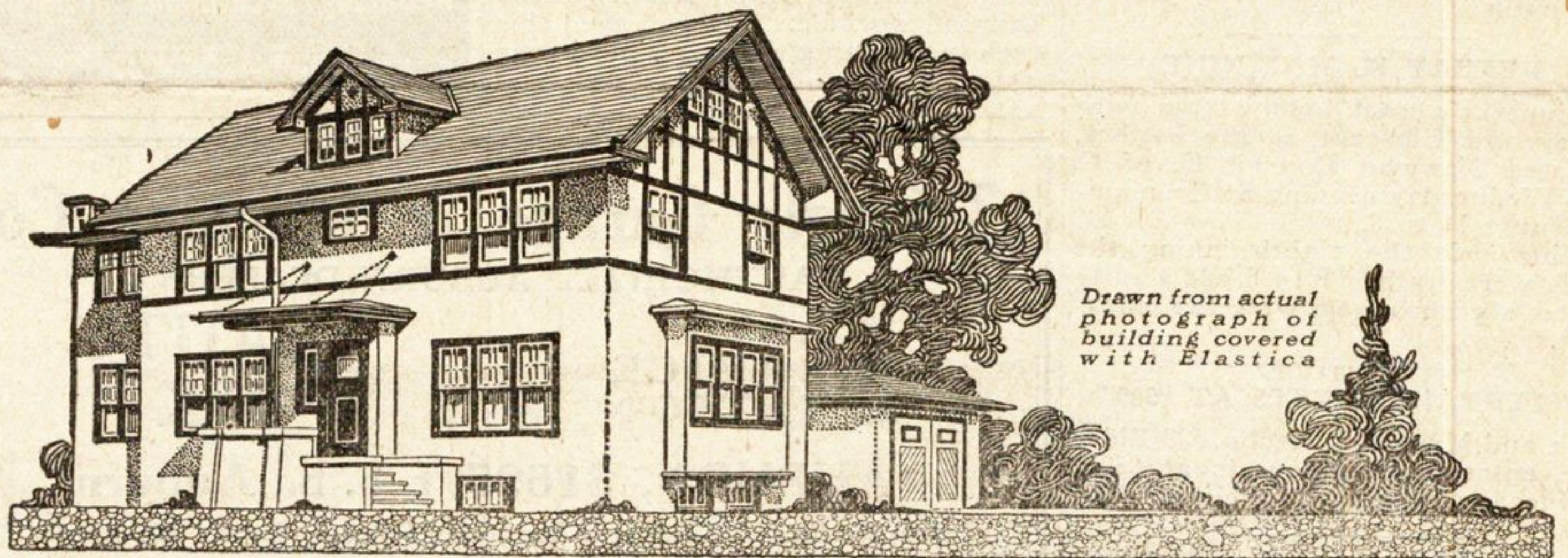
