

SHOW PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN DEPLORABLE STATE

Superintendent Washburne Aids in Publishing Facts Concerning Actual Education Conditions in Illinois

Astounding conditions in the Public schools of Illinois are forcefully revealed in a pamphlet issued recently by Carleton W. Washburne, superintendent of Winnetka schools in collaboration with W. W. Lewton, superintendent of schools at Cicero, Ill., and president of the City Superintendents association, and J. O. Engleman, superintendent of schools of Decatur, Ill., chairman of the Legislative Committee, Illinois State Teachers' association. With Mr. Washburne as chairman, the three educators comprise the Legislative Publicity committee of the Illinois State Teachers' association. The booklet is issued for the express purpose of arousing sentiment among parents of school children and all persons interested in effective and proper instruction of the rising generation that will insist upon increased appropriation for school purposes in the legislative branches of the state government.

The booklet is entitled "The Crisis in Public Education in Illinois". Briefly, these pertinent facts command immediate attention and remedy:
"Illinois schools are running behind \$15,000,000 a year.
"One hundred and sixty thousand children are being taught in unsuitable class rooms and basements.
"Three out of four teachers are undertrained.
"Almost all teachers are underpaid.
"The only way to prevent this situation from becoming worse is to increase the State school fund from \$6,000,000 to \$20,000,000 immediately.
"This increase is less than that which California, New York, Ohio and other states have given.
"Illinois now is second in wealth—24th in educational rank and in support of its schools.
"Normal schools, for want of support, are losing their faculties.
"Immediate help for public schools and normal schools is imperative if they are to survive.
Every department and phase of public school work and cost is thoroughly and frankly discussed in the booklet. Every Winnetka parent and friend of the children should be availed of a copy of the booklet which may be obtained from Superintendent Washburne at the offices in the Horace Mann school.
