THROUGH THE COURTESY of the Indian Hill Golf Club, it has been possible for Northwestern University to revive the Western Inter-collegiate Golf Tournament. The tournament, with entries from nine Western Universities, started last Tuesday with the Team Championship. This event was won by Drake University of Des Moines, Ia. The medal play, thirty-six holes, which decided the Team champions also served as a qualifying round for the Individual championship, sixteen men qualifying.

A heavy rain interrupted the proceedings in the afternoon, and caused somewhat larger scores than in the morning round. The Team Play Results:

The field was led by George Hartman of the University of Chicago who turned in cards of 77-80, 157. Robert McKee of Drake University was runner up with scores of 78-83, 161. Players from University of Wisconsin and DePaul University entered the qualifying round but did not show a full squad for the team event.

This also paves the way for an annual play in this important college event with student golf growing in popularity each year.
