

NO BOND ISSUE ELECTION TODAY

Board of Education Postpones
Special Election: Await Bids
On Greeley School Addition Construction

There is to be no Bond Issue Election in Winnetka today as reported in a previous issue of the Weekly Talk. The election has been indefinitely postponed by the Winnetka Board of Education to await the receipt of bids and, what is expected to be an attendant reduction of the estimated cost of building an addition to the Greeley school.

Voters in the village are given this notice so that no person may be inconvenienced by going to the voting place at Horace Mann school today only to be disappointed.

Several weeks ago when the Weekly Talk received official information of the proposed special election the Board of Education had decided to place before the voters, immediately, the proposition of issuing bonds to cover the expense of building a large addition to the Greeley school to better accommodate the Primary grades of the public schools.

Since that time, however, the Board of Education has changed its plan and determined not to hold the election until bids for construction were received.
