Professions Lose Ground

At the recent meeting of the American Institute of Homeopathy it was reported that the United States is in need today of 25,000 physicians. Other professions, notably that of education, are suffering from a similar depletion of the ranks of entrants, the attractions of the business life proving to be too strong for young men and women who are entering upon serious careers. The greater opportunity to rise in business, the institution by colleges of courses in business administration and other forms of commercial activity, have served to divert the stream of purposeful youth from the professions into the great world of business enterprise.

In large measure the beginning of the departure from the professions is due to the difference in recompense which a person of scientific training in any field could command in the business world and the salary that was awarded the instructor in all our educational system. The greater altitude and variety of activity have had also their part in the direction of the trained men and women from educational institutions into business. The recognition of the inferior salaries of teachers as compared with that that good work in business could command has served to discourage the adoption of that profession by college graduates. The long period of preparation valuable time lost during the years of service in the war have had their part also in inducing young men to enter the commercial courses in their belated college careers, and produced their effect upon the number of recruits to the various professions.

But the world must have physicians, teachers, lawyers, preachers, and the way to bring young men and women into these professions is obvious, to reduce the disadvantages of such application of their talents to a point more nearly equal with those that exist in other lines of endeavor. The professions will have to make themselves attractive if they are not to suffer still more from the withdrawal of those already specially trained and the rejection by young men and women as possible careers.

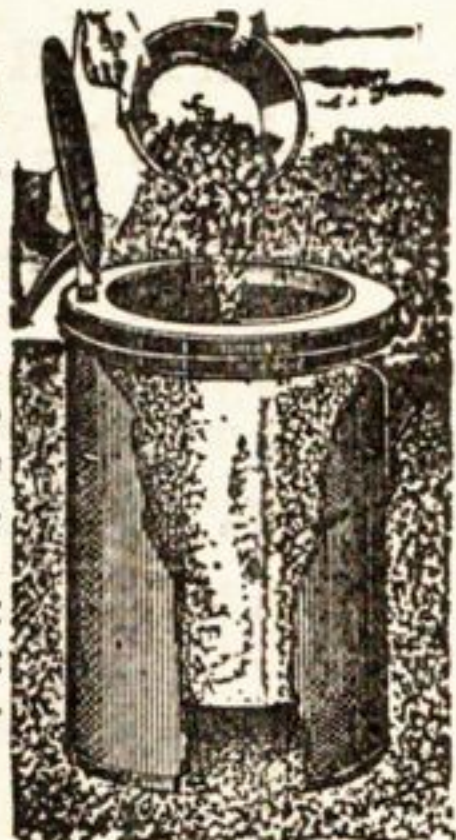
