GOVERNOR ORDERS ROAD IMPROVEMENT

Asks Immediate Construction of 145 Miles of Hard Road Pavement in Various Sections of Illinois

Springfield, Ill.-Governor Small has ordered the immediate construction of approximately 145 miles of hard road pavement, if fair prices are offered by contractors for the work. Bids will be opened here on August 23.

The governor's announcement followed a recent tour of road inspection in the northern and eastern parts of the state. The proposed roads are to be built in numerous counties located in all parts of the state.

The Division of Highways has received instructions to receive the bids on the work and to open bids in Springfield on August 23. The letting already has been advertised for that date by the division. The advertisement calls for bids on the following stretches of road:
