

### HARVARD HONORS WINNETKA MAN; NAMED ALUMNI HEAD

William Cowper Boyden, 725 Pine street, who once gave a check for \$100,000 to Harvard University in memory of his class of 1886, was this week accorded the distinction of election to the presidency of the Harvard Alumni association, according to word received from the university. The election came as a fitting reward for his devotion to his alma mater.

Mr. Boyden, who is a prominent Chicago attorney, was formerly president of the Harvard club of Chicago, the Western Associated Harvard clubs, the University club and the Chicago Bar association. He has been a resident of Winnetka for many years always assuming a leading part in local civic affairs.
