

Realty Board Reports On Housing Shortage

Committee of North Shore Real Estate Board Responds To Requests Made by Secretary Hoover

The regular monthly meeting of the North Shore Real Estate board was held at the offices of Justice C. T. Northrop in Winnetka last Monday evening. A representative gathering of the north shore real estate men was in attendance, and matters of interest to the north shore taken up. A communication from the National Real Estate board at Washington, D. C., relative to the removal from real estate of the excessive burden of taxation while municipal bonds and other securities are entirely tax exempt was read and discussed at length.

Frederick H. Thomas of the firm bearing that name, H. H. Brown of Murray and Terry, and G. H. Engelhart of McGuire and Orr were appointed on a Federal committee, in response to a request from Secretary of Commerce Hoover for such a committee, to report on the local housing shortage, average percentage of loans in regard to total value of prop-

erty, ground value compared to value of homes, proportion of homes occupied by owners, etc.

At the state realtor's convention which is in session at Peoria this week, Justice Northrop, president, and Mrs. E. R. Stone, secretary of the North Shore Board, will be official representatives of the local board.

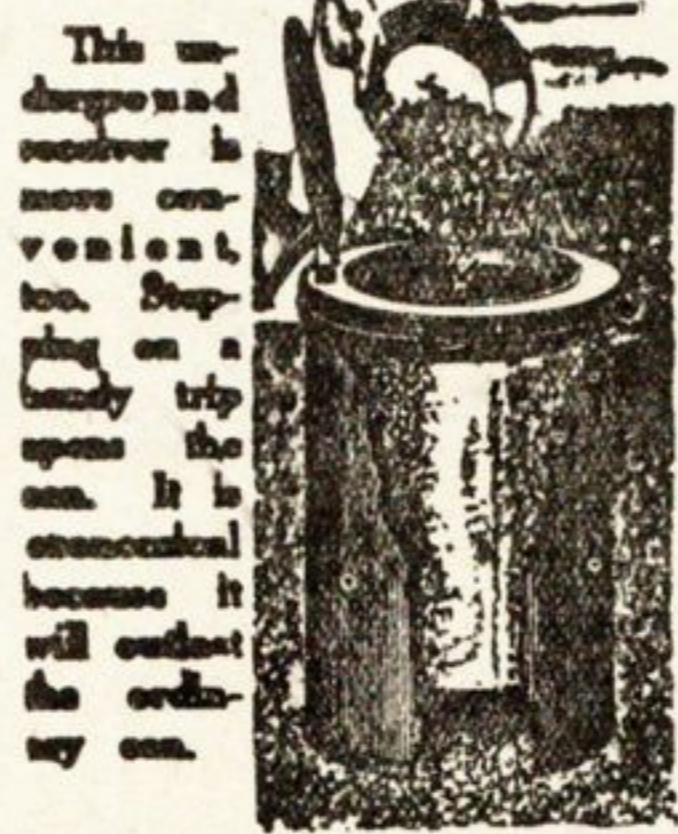

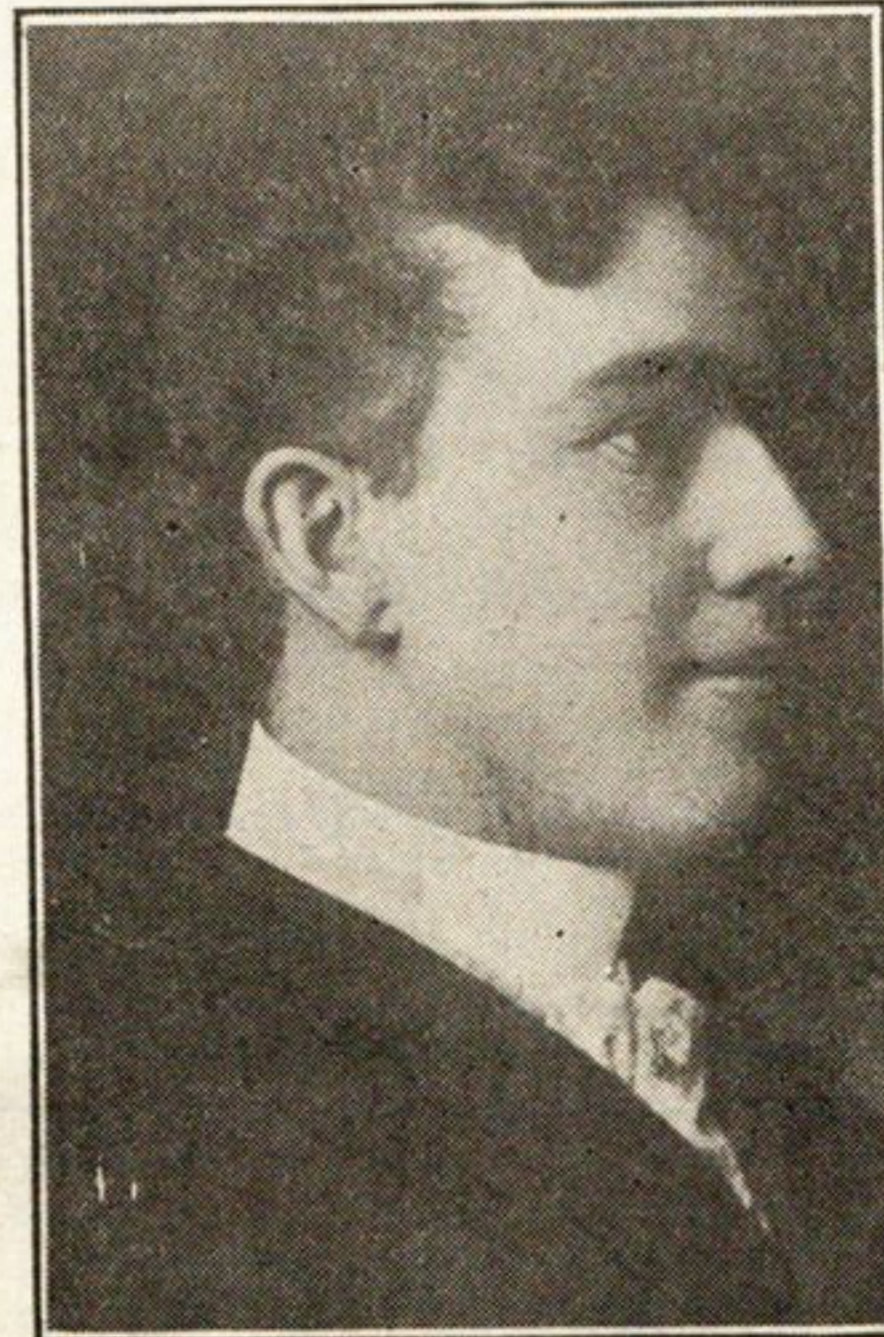
