

**Spanish Drama Billed
For Community House**

Next Attraction at Winnetka Community House to Feature Miriam Cooper and George Walsh

Miriam Cooper, the pretty actress who bewitched thousands by her portrayal of one of the Cameron sisters in "The Birth of a Nation," and in "Intolerance" will appear at the Community House, next Friday evening, in "Serenade," an R. A. Walsh-First National attraction. In this picture Miss Cooper takes the part of a Spanish senorita, and invests the role with such an air of sincerity and fidelity that it becomes a classic in histrionic powers. Playing opposite Miss Cooper is George Walsh, handsome and athletic,
