

GRAHAM TRUCKS PROVE POPULAR

Light and powerful and sturdily constructed, Graham Brothers trucks carry 1 ton and 1½ ton loads at a safe speed of 20 to 30 miles an hour. Real versatility has been shown by the makers in providing body types that cover the whole field of business needs, and each type is shipped from Detroit or Evansville, Ind., complete with cab and body.

Commenting on the approval Graham Brothers truck has won among owners everywhere, W. T. Wehrstedt, local Dodge Brothers dealer says: "It is certain that Dodge Brothers never would have permitted their name to be associated with this truck if they had not first satisfied themselves that it was thoroughly reliable and that it offered the owner advantages which could not be obtained in other equipments already on the market.

"Comparative figures reveal some interesting facts about the field of 1 ton and 1½ ton trucks. Compared with the average of 50 other leading 1½ ton trucks, Graham Brothers 1½ ton truck not only weighs 1500 pounds less, but is \$960 below the average price of the other 50. The horsepower rating of its Dodge Brothers motor is 24.5, which is 2 to 3½ more h. p. than the average of 50 other 1½ ton trucks or 50 one ton trucks. Graham Brothers 1 ton truck is 650 pounds below the average weight of 50 other 1 ton trucks, and sells for \$400 less. And the cost of repair parts for Graham Brothers trucks, both 1 ton and 1½ ton size, runs just about 50 per cent lower than for other trucks of the same capacity.

Graham Brothers truck is cord tire equipped, with rear 34x5s on the 1 ton type, and rear 36x6s on the 1½ ton truck. The types most in demand at present are stake bodies, canopy bodies, express bodies, and school bus bodies.

HEALTH RESORT PROCEEDS WITH CONSTRUCTION WORK

The addition is to be erected south of and adjoining the present building.

Winnetka Leads Way In Home Construction

Superintendent Gibbon Declares Residence Building Permits for Year Will Be \$1,250,000

Area and population of the village considered Winnetka leads, not only the north shore, but all the Chicago suburban territory in the number and valuation of building permits issued. Indications are that Winnetka, at the close of the fiscal year, April 1, 1922, will have issued home building permits in excess of \$1,250,000, and at the rate of 10 permits a week with the average valuation at more than \$10,000. "At this rate," says Superintendent Gibbon, "it will be difficult to find vacant property in the village with a fine tooth comb after another few years. We have the busiest building permit offices on the north shore, and leading material concerns say Winnetka is leading every other community in the vicinity of Chicago.

"Many of the homes now under construction in the village are valued at well over the \$30,000 mark. Scores of beautiful bungalows are being erected at a cost in each instance in excess of \$10,000. In estimating the year's issue of permits at \$1,250,000, I am not including permits for garages or commercial establishments. That figure represents homes, every one of them a distinct credit to the village."

PILE OF LUMBER BRINGS F. SORENSON INTO COURT

A pile of lumber, unprotected by the required red lights, brought F. Sorenson, Chicago building contractor, into the Winnetka police court this week, after Chief of Police Peterson, while driving his car at night, narrowly avoided crashing into the red lightless lumber pile on the side of the street at 67 Warwick road.

Sorenson admitted negligence and was assessed a fine of \$5 and costs.

It was pointed out, in connection with the case in question, that contractors placing building materials on parkways or at street sides must have a special permit and must place red lights on such obstructions. Violators of the ordinance in that regard face arrest and heavy fine. It is stipulated, also, that the obstructions must be removed as quickly as possible.
