

### "THREE MUSKETEERS" SHOWS AT WINNETKA

Famous Fairbanks Film to be Presented at Winnetka Community House on January 4, 5 and 6

Definite announcement was made this week that Douglas Fairbanks will appear at the Winnetka Community House, January 4, 5 and 6 in Alexandre Dumas' immortal story, "The Three Musketeers."

The film version of "The Three Musketeers" is based not only upon the famous novel of Alexander Dumas, but also upon the memoirs of D'Artagnan himself. In fact, much of the material upon which the "business" of the photoplay is built, much that gives it the human touch, was found in D' Artagnan's memoirs and not in the novel, although it was from the Dumas story that the foundation stones for the picture plot were obtained.

A special prologue has been arranged to precede the "Three Musketeers" and a musical accompaniment, written by Louis Gottschalk, the noted composer, will be rendered during the picture.

Owing to existing contracts with the United Artists corporation, the distributor of "The Three Musketeers," it is necessary to charge a minimum admission fee of fifty cents, but it must be remembered that this picture which is being shown for the first time on the north shore, is con-

sidered Douglas Fairbanks' greatest screen triumph.

The picture will be shown at 4 and 8 o'clock each day.

### NEARLY 28,000 MILES OF GOOD ROADS BUILT IN 1921

Road building has recovered from the setback received during the war, and prospects are bright for the future. Approximately 14,000 miles of road have been constructed during the present season by the States in conjunction with Federal aid, according to the Bureau of Public Roads, United States Department of Agriculture, and probably an equal amount independent of Federal aid. More miles of improved road have been built than during any other year.

Costs of road grading and construction with local materials is down practically to the 1914 level. Some reductions, also, have been made in freight rates on road materials. The importance of this item is shown by the fact that in some cases it has been estimated that increased freight rates have added 10 per cent to the cost of a road. Prices of manufactured road materials tend downward; the present level is materially lower than that of a year ago.

With the new appropriation by Congress of \$75,000,000, added impetus will be given to new road construction. Many of the States are considering enlarged amounts of State aid, and the new law will have

a tendency to encourage this policy. It will also secure the construction of a system of interstate and inter-country highways, rather than haphazard selection of roads as in some cases in the past.

The meeting of the Association of State Highway Officials to be held in Omaha, Nebr., December 5 to 12, will be devoted largely to the discussion of ways and means of complying with the new law and getting construction under way.
