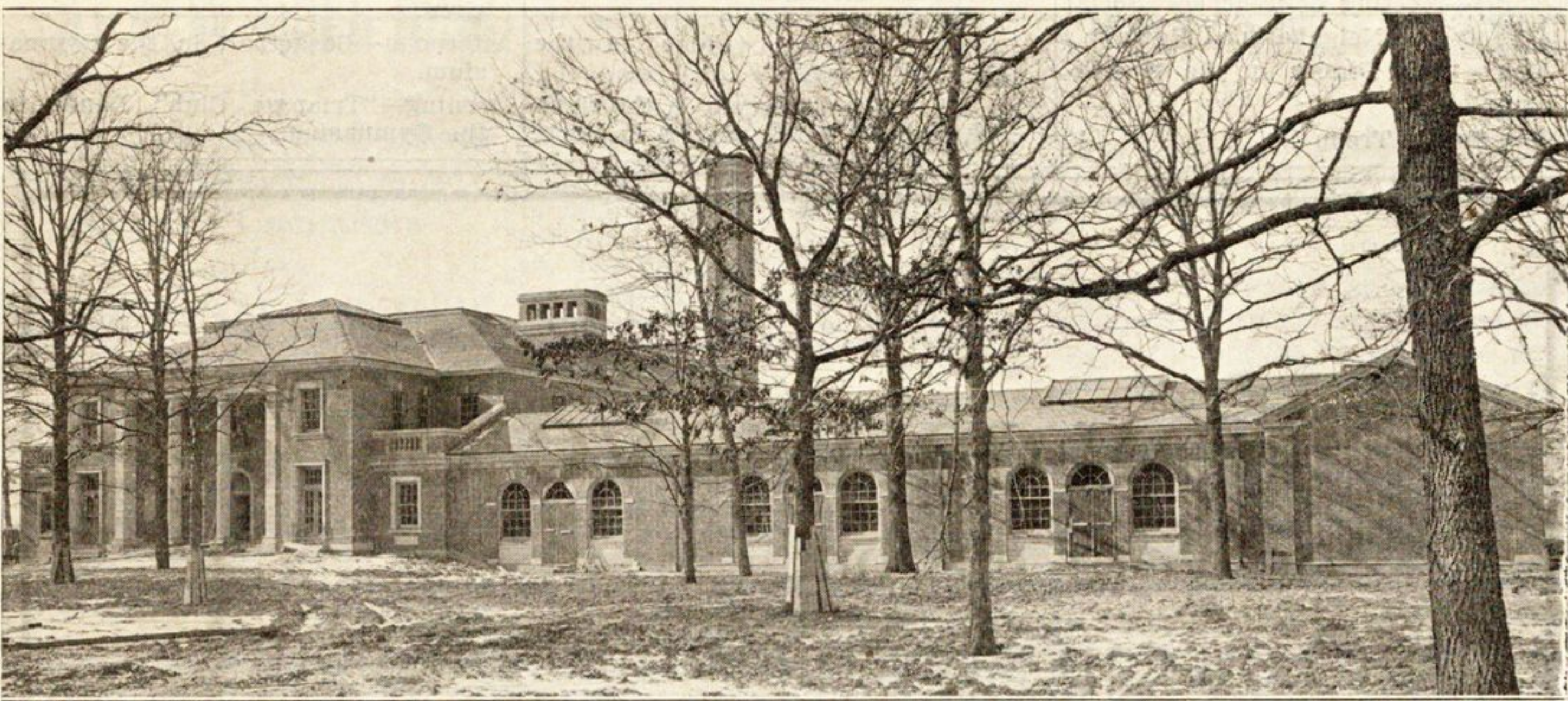

Summer Rates to Coast Cut by Four Railroads

Chicago—Summer tourist rates from the middle west to the Pacific coast will be approximately \$20 less per round trip than they were last year on four railroads. The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe; the Chicago, Milwaukee and St. Paul; Chicago and North-western and the Union Pacific lines are the roads that have announced fare reductions.

The new fare, round trip, from Chicago to California will be \$86, from Omaha and Kansas City, \$72, from Denver \$62, and from Minneapolis and St. Paul to North Pacific coast, \$72.

Bonzano Will Be Created Cardinal at Consistory

Rome—Monsignor Bonzano, apostolic delegate to the United States, will be created a Cardinal at the Roman Catholic Consistory next month, it was learned from a source close to the Vatican today.

and secretary of state in President Wilson's cabinet, today declined to become a candidate for the United States Senate to succeed Senator Park Trammel of Florida.

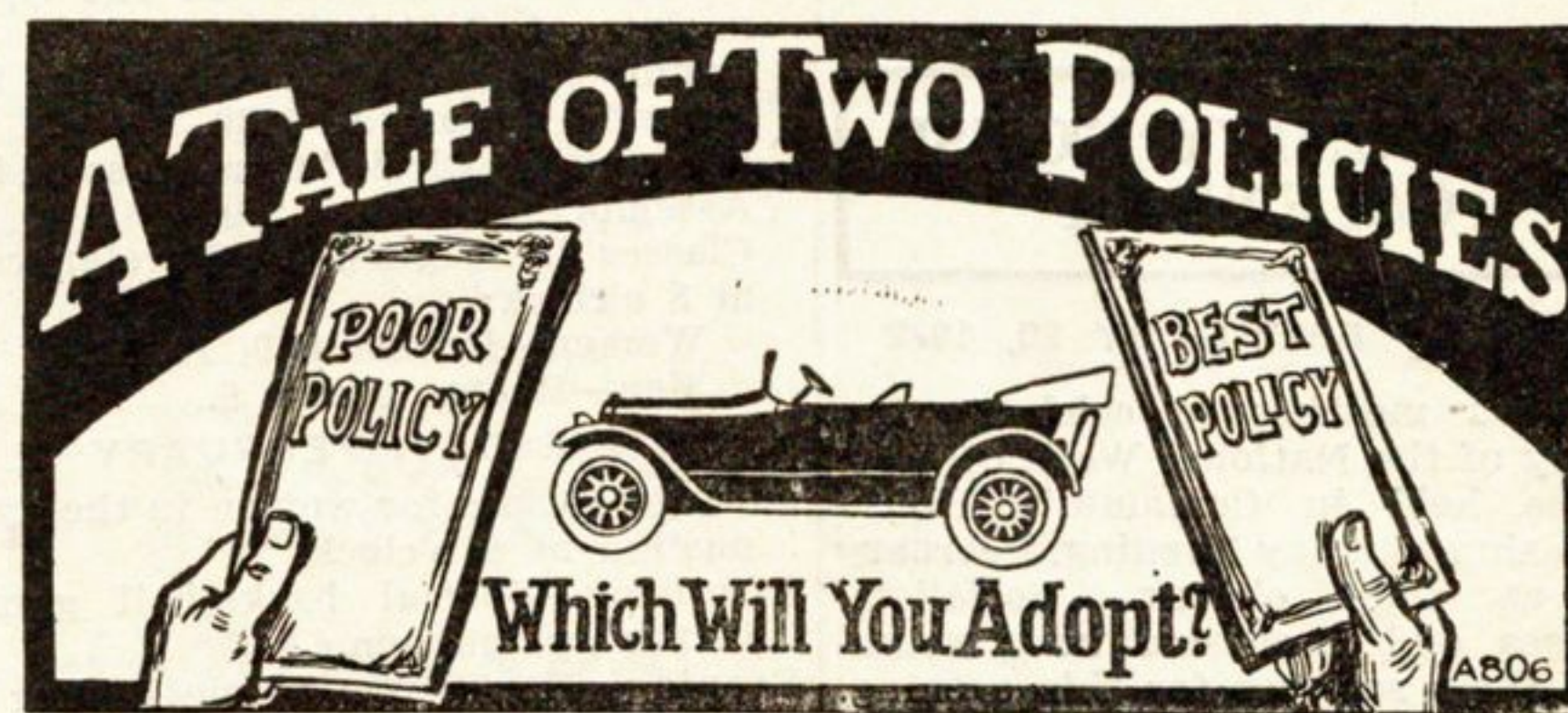
