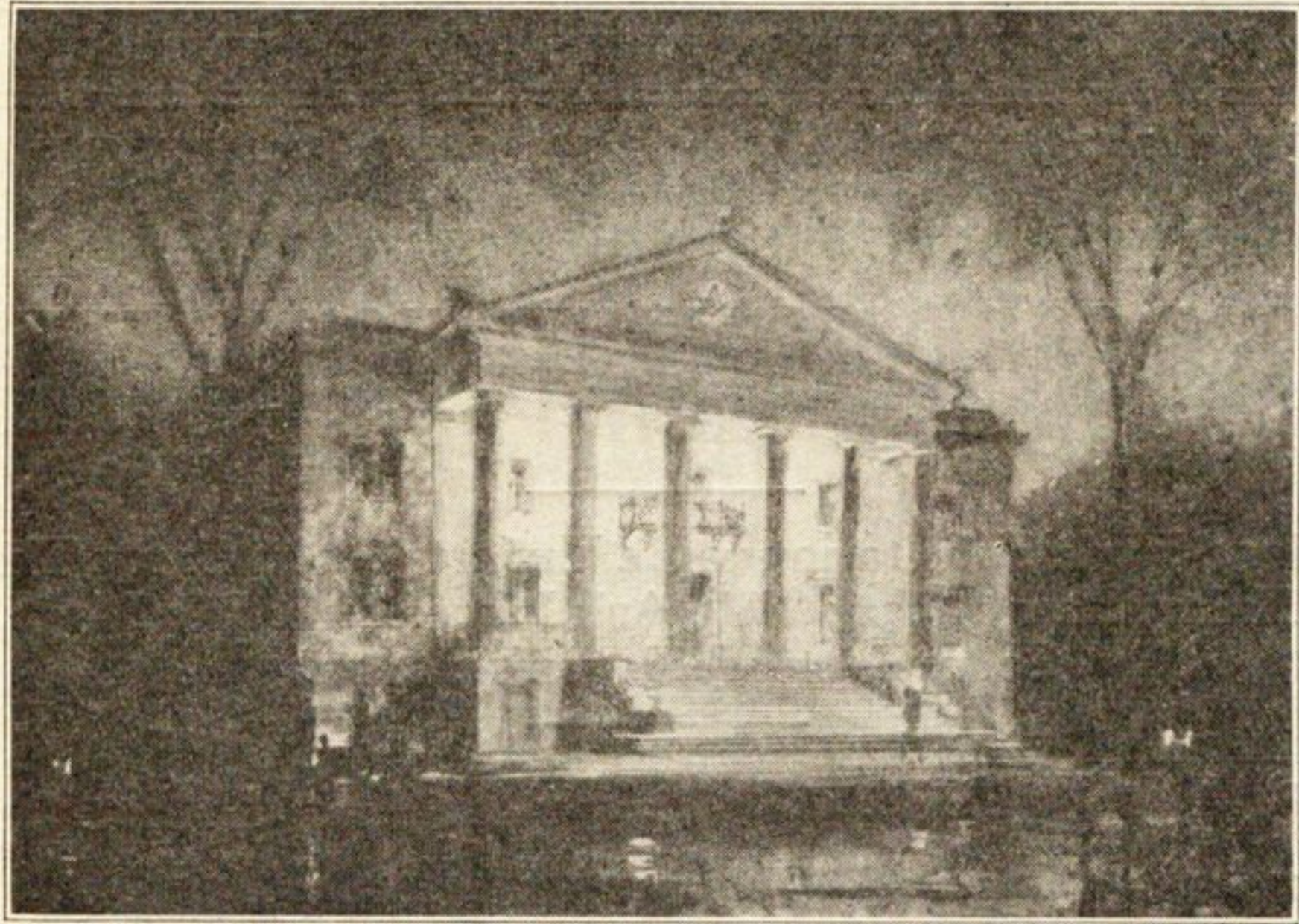


WINNETKA'S MASONIC TEMPLE

Attractive Structure Expected to Be Completed Sometime This Fall



Winnetka can soon claim the honor of having one of the finest Masonic Temples in Illinois. The Winnetka Talk is glad to be able to reproduce the architects design of this new building which will soon be under construction on Lincoln avenue.

Winnetka has gained a reputation throughout the country as "A town where people pull together." The remarkable progress which has marked the short history of this new organization is good evidence that this is true.

It was but a few months ago that several loyal and energetic Masons met to discuss the possibility of forming a new Lodge in Winnetka. There seemed to be a growing need for a new lodge. Everyone was enthusiastically for it. In a short time 245 Masons had signed the petition which was submitted to the Grand Lodge asking for dispensation.

Record Charter Membership

The institution ceremonies were held at the Community House April 12. Nearly five hundred Masons, including seventeen Past Masters and several officers from the Grand Lodge, attended. The instituting officer from the Grand Lodge complimented the new lodge on the progress shown and stated that the Winnetka petition contained the largest number of Charter Members of any petition presented in recent months.

The new Temple will cost approximately \$125,000. It will be financed by subscriptions from the lodge members. It will be complete in every

respect. Besides the rooms required for lodge work, there will be bowling alleys, pool and billiard room, library, dining room and dance floor.

At the last meeting of the lodge when the plans for the Temple were presented and approved 100 per cent of those present subscribed to the Temple fund. It is expected that there will be a 100 per cent subscription throughout the membership.

Ready in Autumn

If present plans are carried through Winnetka Masons will be in their new Temple by the time they receive their charter which will be some time next fall. Seldom, if ever, has such a record been made by a new Masonic organization. It is an achievement of which all residents in Winnetka could be proud.
