Book Reviews

A Magnificently Unlived Life

Let us have no Margery Darwinian complex and frankly admit at the start that there is no Peter Whiffle. Therefore, he could not have written any books, and, consequently, in writing "The Life and Works of Peter Whiffle, Carl Von Vetchen was merely pleasing himself—and incidentally us—with an exquisite piece of elaborate fooling.

Besides being a well written piece of work he has exactly caught the note that Hunecker sounds in his books of reminiscences and blends the actual and the probable with the fic-

ticious in such perfect proportions that they add veracity to—what would never be—a bald and unconvincing narrative.

As for the story itself there is little to say. It purports to be the life history, told mostly in flashes and cut backs of one Peter Whiffle, a young gentleman possessed of independent means, the literary temperament, the impecuniousness of genius and the utter inability of making a decision on any matter whatsoever. His unpub-

lished—nay unwritten—books, his unconsummated marriage and his unfortunate decease long before the reader is tired of him are all deliciously set forth.

If—as Peter himself quotes—style is the passport to posterity, this book is surely Mr. Von Vetchen's vise.
