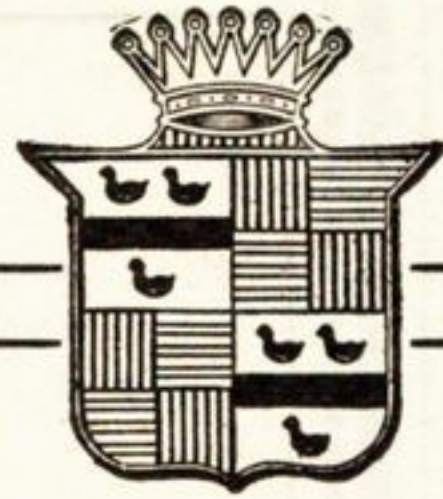
**END ITALIAN STRIKE**

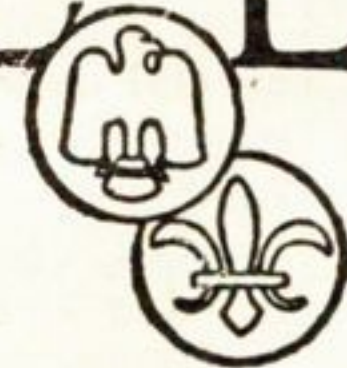
