

## VILLAGES ENDORSE NEW TRIER OUTING

Ask Residents to Observe  
Holiday August 23

New Trier Day, annual township outing event sponsored by the New Trier Commercial association, was officially endorsed by the Wilmette Board of Trustees at its regular meeting Tuesday evening of this week.

The action of the trustees resulted in a proclamation issued by Village President Zipf. The proclamation reads:

### The Proclamation

Whereas, in accordance with established custom, the New Trier Commercial Association, comprising business men of New Trier Township, including the Village of Wilmette, has designated Wednesday, August 23, 1922, as New Trier Day, and

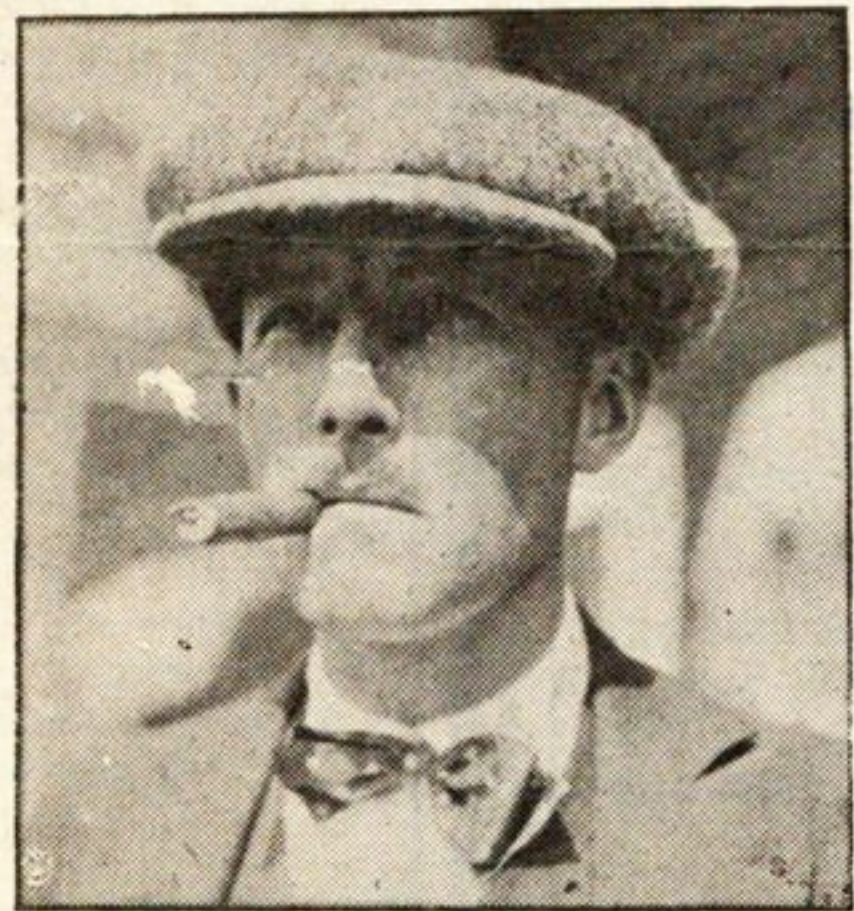
Whereas, New Trier Day, thus designated is the occasion of a general picnic and outing for business people, their employees, and residents of the township and village.

Therefore, I, Edward Zipf, as President of the Village of Wilmette, do recommend that Wednesday, August 23, 1922, be observed generally throughout the village as a holiday. In witness whereof I hereby set my hand and affix the corporate seal this fifteenth day of August, A. D. 1922.

### "Bill" Crouse Promises To Be "Sandwich King"

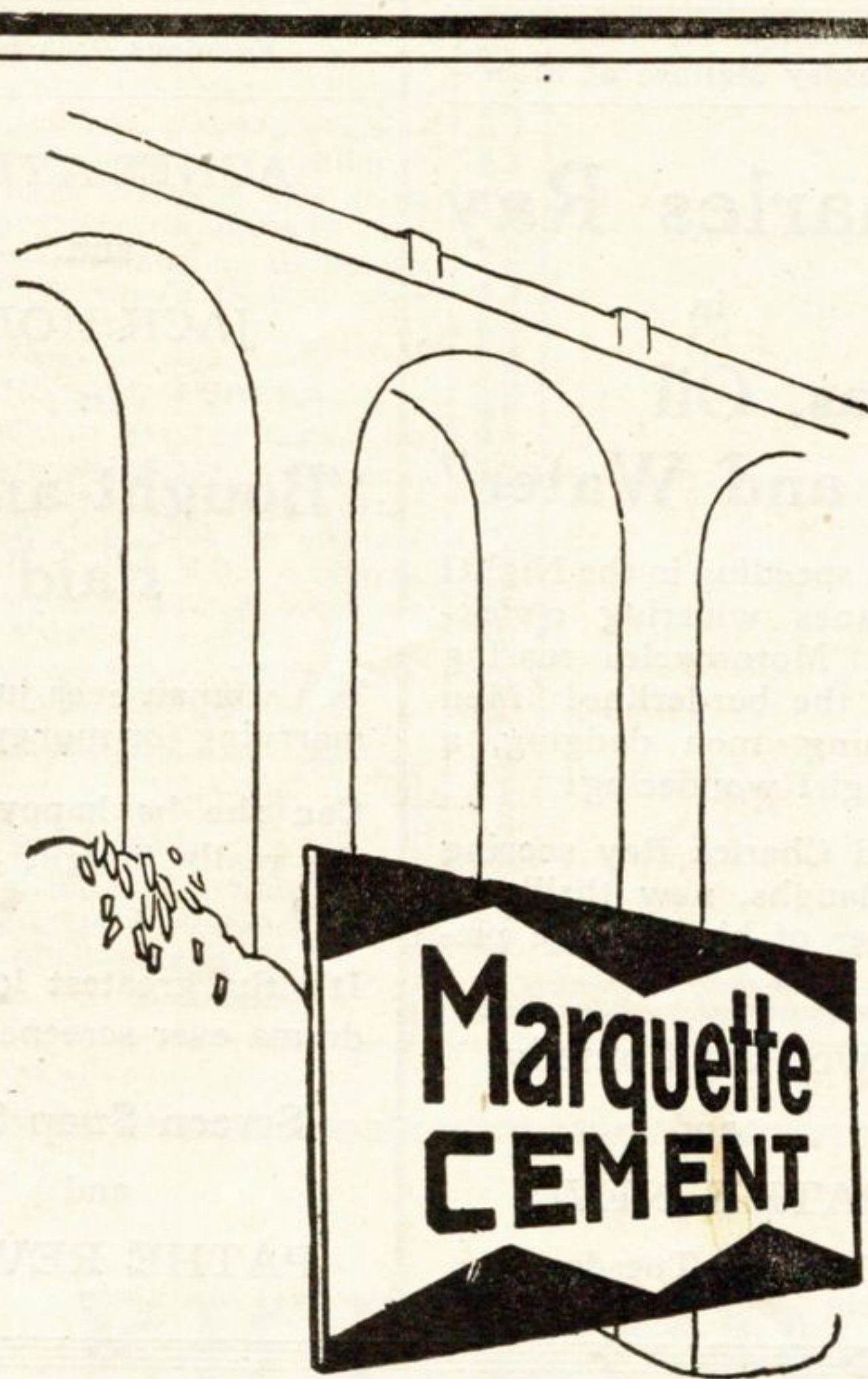
