Well, there's no feminine equivalent for such a name, unless it's Doina.

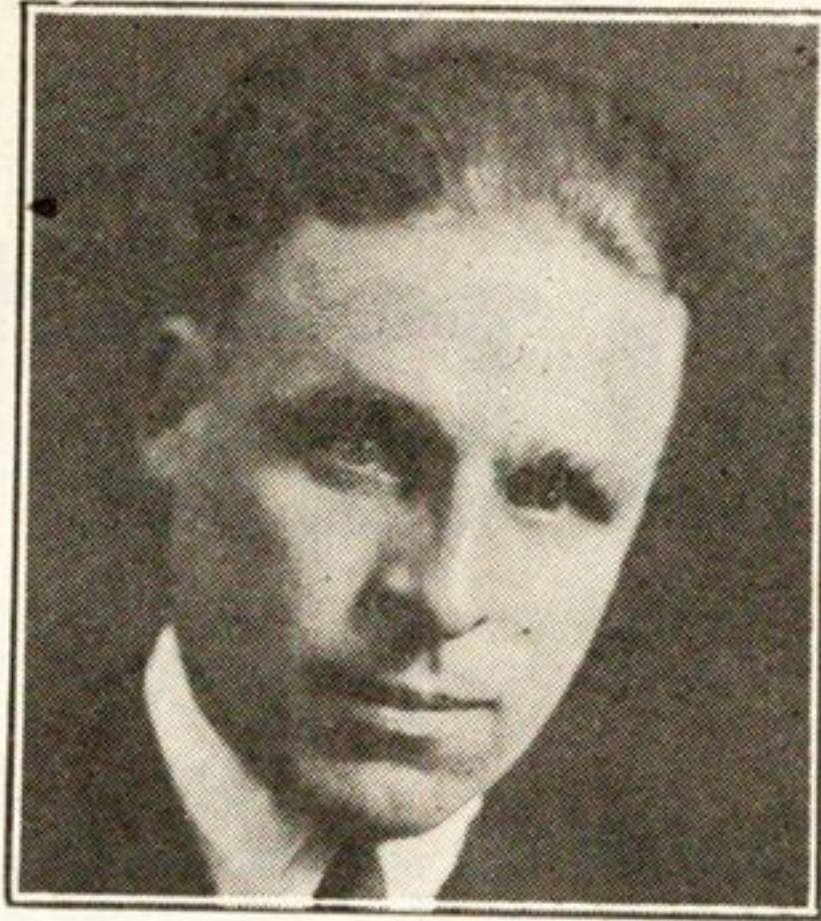
Wine, Spaghetti and Heat Served at Naples, Says Andy
