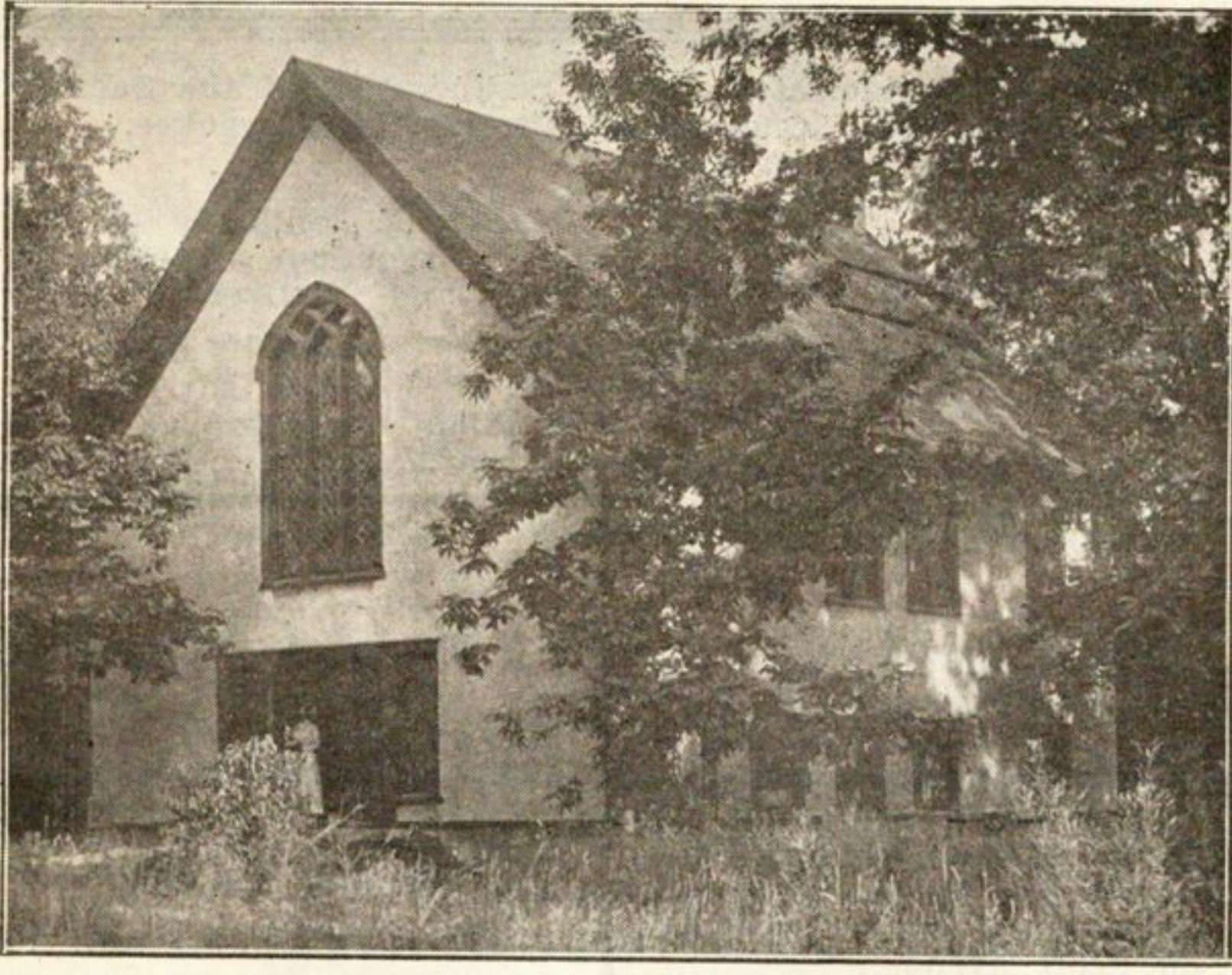


FIRST SCANDINAVIAN EVANGELICAL CHURCH

\$12,000 Home Leads List Of Week's Building Permits

Two residences, a storehouse, and four garages comprise the list of building permits issued by the village board the past week.

W. H. Bennett received a permit to build a \$12,000 residence at 579 Hill Terrace. J. Salmen was granted permission to erect a home at 815 Foxdale, costing \$7,000. J. O. Mason, 857 Ash street, was also granted a permit for a residence. It is to cost \$3,000.

The storehouse is to be built by E. O. Sullivan at 550 Ash, costing \$1,000. The garage permits were granted to Leslie M. Gooder, costing \$500, John Schwall, \$200, G. A. Watson, \$250, and Daniel Johnson, \$150.

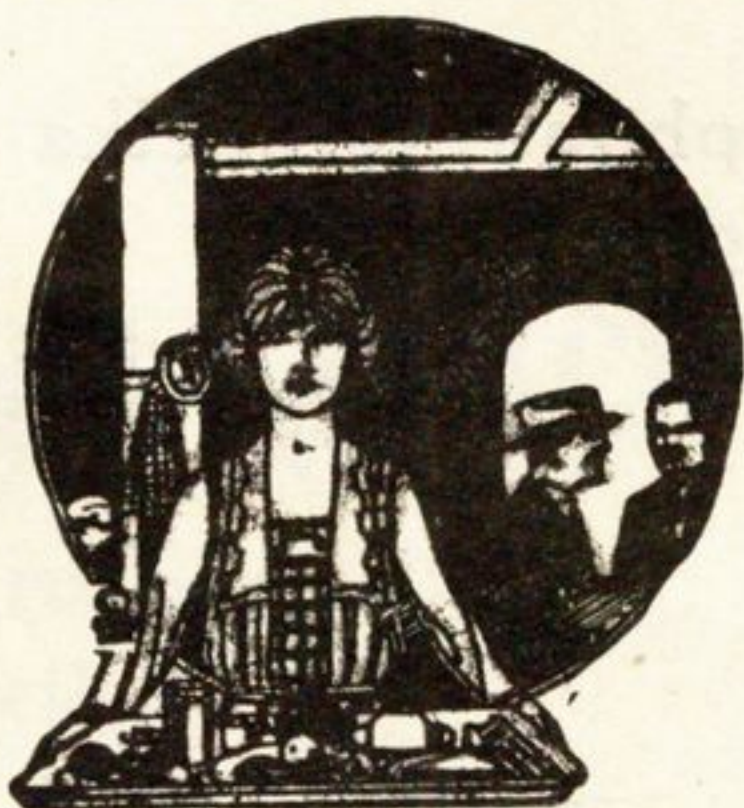
