Nicolson was chosen secretary. After giving brief digests of remarks made by Governors Henry J. Allen of Kansas and Nathan L. "The greatness of the scheme as a whole lies in its importance to the entire middle west, embracing as it does more than a third of the area, population and wealth of our country, all of which will be benefited tremendously by improved and cheapened transportations," concluded the report in urging the citizens of Illinois to support the plan.
