Merchants Plan Protection Against "Charities"

The New Trier Commercial association is to be host to all the business men of New Trier township Monday evening, October 16, at a dinner at Winnetka Community House. The association voted the dinner at its regular meeting Monday evening of this week.

It is the plan of the association to secure some municipal leader in the township as speaker at the dinner, and a special program of music is to be arranged as an additional feature, it is said.

After "Charity Sharks"

The Commercial association Monday evening discussed various matters of interest to local business men, includ-

ing the question of issuing identification certificates to representatives of responsible charities who solicit on the north shore. Several business men complained that solicitation for numerous charity projects was becoming so promiscuous as to constitute a nuisance. Issuance of identification cards, it is felt, would have the result of discouraging solicitors who are not identified with organizations of recognized worth. It was decided to seek the co-operation of officials in the various villages to achieve this purpose.

Investigate Peddling

The association voted to investigate the ordinances in the various villages of the township in regard to peddlers' licenses. A committee was appointed to report back to the association on that matter at the next meeting.

The question of installing an ornamental lighting system in the Winnetka business district brought action at the association meeting which is to result in a meeting to be held at Winnetka Community House Monday evening, September 25, and to which all Winnetka business men are to be invited for the purpose of a general discussion of the question.

The matter of instituting police pension funds in the various villages

of the township was another question discussed at Monday's session. A committee was appointed to investigate and report back to the association at its next regular meeting.
