CALLS ADVERTISING KEY TO PROSPERITY

Illustrates Effect on Electric Railways

Green Bay, Wis.—Present growing electric railway prosperity can be accentuated by persistent advertising, Labert St. Clair, of New York, director of the Advertising Section, American Electric Railway association, declared at the conference of the Wisconsin Utilities association held here.

"Electric railways are coming back financially virtually throughout the United States and Canada," Mr. St. Clair said. "During 1922 only four companies, capiltized at \$13,000,000, have gone into receiverships as compared with eighty companies capitalized at \$630,000,000 during the preceding three years. Many companies in receiverships also have come out in the last year. New equipment is being bought and property improved generally.

"This improved condition is due chiefly to increased riding—some 10,-000,000 more persons rode during June, 1922, than in June, 1921—lower material and labor costs, and finally, improved public relations. The public's good will has translated itself into the curbing of unfair competition, sustaining fair rates of fare and a square deal for the companies all around by the public which demands facts and declines to listen to demagogues.

"I do not want to be understood as saying that every company in the country is prosperous. That is not the case. There are many managers who still are having a struggle. But I do say that things are getting better generally and there is hope for all.

"One of the gravest dangers which now confronts the industry is that managements, satisfied with their increasing prosperity, will neglect their public relations. The management which now cuts down public relations work is making a costly mistake."


