Local Women Interested in School Fund Campaign

Women prominent in north shore and educational social activities are interested at this time in the campaign in progress to secure an endowment fund for Lake Erie College, Painesville, Ohio.

The institution has been given the highest rating of any school in its class by the General Education Board of the Rockefeller Foundation. A \$500,000 endowment fund is sought and the foundation promises to give \$200,000 contingent upon the college raising the remaining \$300,000 from other sources. The college has instituted a campaign to raise the \$300,000 and an additional \$500,000 for building and equipment.
