

## SAYS SCIENCE FINDS CHRISTIAN LIFE BEST

Pastor Cites "Voices From  
the Road-Side"

The Sermon at the Winnetka Congregational church last Sunday morning dealt with some of the voices being heard to-day in advocacy of the Christian way of life but coming from unexpected sources. Mr. Richards said in part:

### Biology Preaches

"One road-side voice is that of biology. It is really an astonishing conversation. Biology and Christianity were long supposed to be hopelessly opposed. Careful reflection has for most people removed this feeling of opposition. And then biology has gone right forward into new fields. From the work of a filing clerk it aspires to that of production manager. Now in the persons of many of its leaders it is actually talking the language of the New Testament. One of its recent writers has declared that eugenics is just the projection of the golden rule down the stream of protoplasm, that the state has never yet discovered more than half of Christianity and to the part that applies to the living it must add the part applicable to the more numerous unborn, that Jesus proposed more abundant life for them as much as for anybody and that if he were here to-day he might say, "Do unto the born and the unborn as you would have the born and the unborn do unto you." Biology has donned the cloth and climbed the pulpit and begun to preach.

### Unselfishness Brings Health

"But perhaps the clearest new voice from the road-side is that of psychology. It is not too much to say that modern psychology has demonstrated that the human organism, brain and nerves and muscles and organs, is actually constructed for the Christian way of life and for no other. It will not run on any other plan so well. Selfishness and introspection mean mental and physical disorder, weakness, fatigue and futility. The very laws of Jesus are written into your constitution, built into your nature. The unselfish care for the welfare of others is the only sure foundation of health and happiness.

### Psychology "Gets Religion"

"I am not now quoting the sayings of moralists or of religionists. These are the calm conclusions of psychological science derived from exhaustive investigations of the human mind and the study of thousands upon thousands of unhappy, nervous, distracted persons. There is a moral and a spiritual stimulus in the new psychology like bugles going by. Fear and anxiety and self-pity are ruled out by it as sternly as by Jesus. In its own way it cries out that he who finds his life shall lose it and he who loses his life shall find it, and over its laboratories and clinics might be written his words, "Thou shalt love thy God and thy neighbor as thyself. Seek first the Kingdom of God."

"Psychology has been converted. It has 'got religion'. It has joined the church. It has entered the ministry. It has begun to preach the gospel of the Master's way of life."

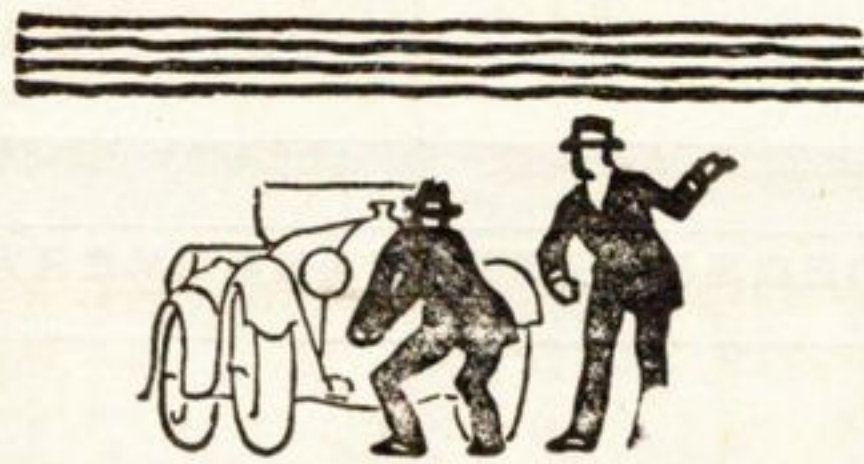
ernment inspection, certification of products, and the use of railroad terminal facilities; that the government be urged to take the necessary steps to increase the production of nitrates and other necessary chemical elements needed in agriculture by the completion and utilization of plants already in process of construction, and that in the event of the refusal of Congress to approve such government operation the government be urged to accept the offer which best safeguards this great asset still owned by the people; that continued support be given to the Federal Trade Commission, also to all effective work of the Department of Agriculture and the Department of Justice, tending to prevent unfair acts by combinations, including open price associations, which unduly increase the cost of living; endorsement of a thorough governmental investigation of the costs of producing and distributing coal in the United States and the publishing of the reports of such investigation.

The Convention of the Illinois League of Women Voters, which took place November 14-15-16 in Chicago will be thoroughly reported next week.

### Francis Payne Mason, Noted Engineer, Is Taken by Death

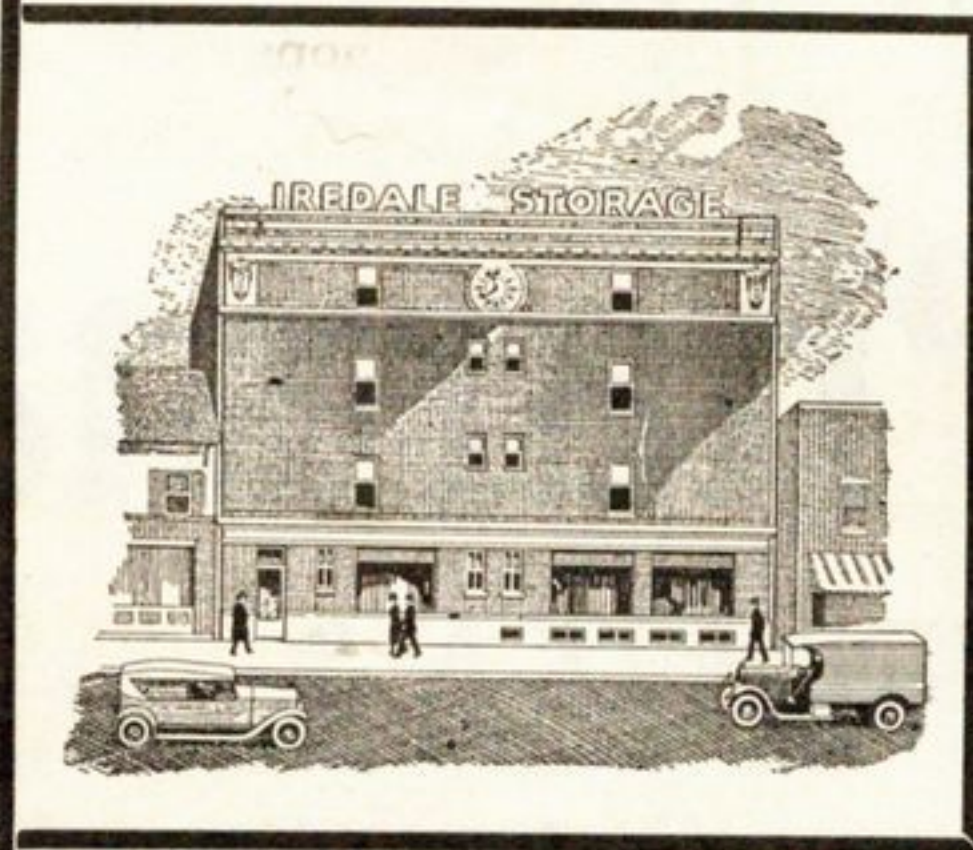

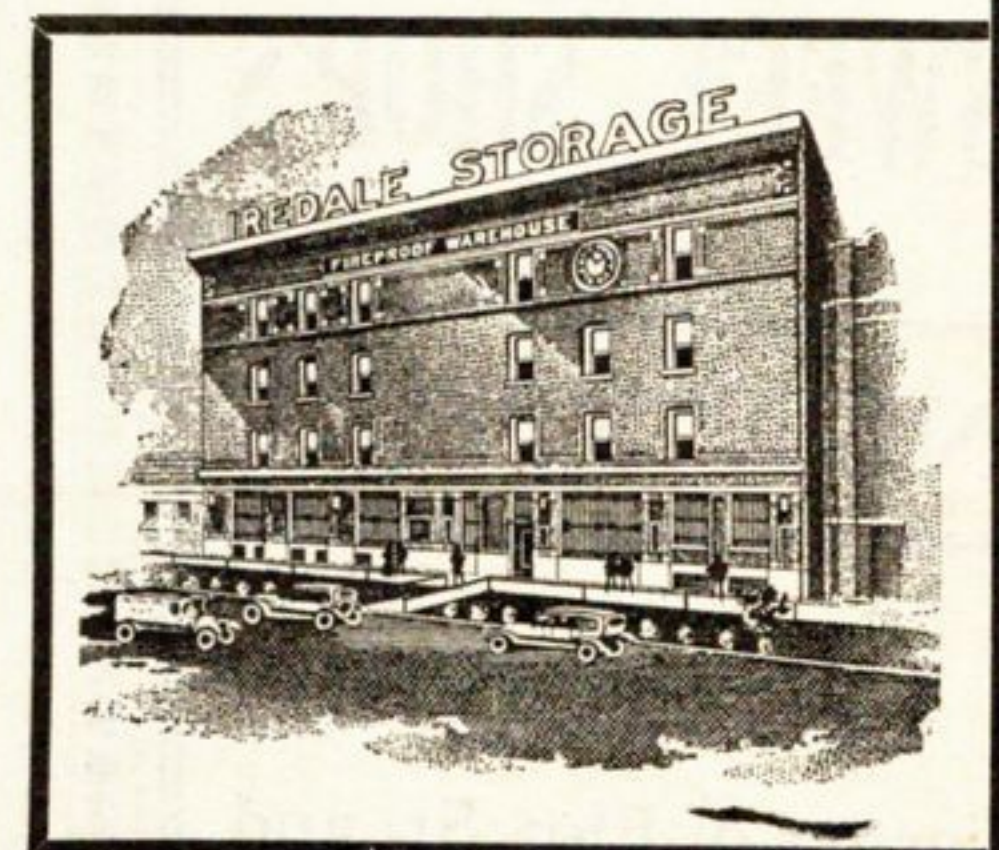
